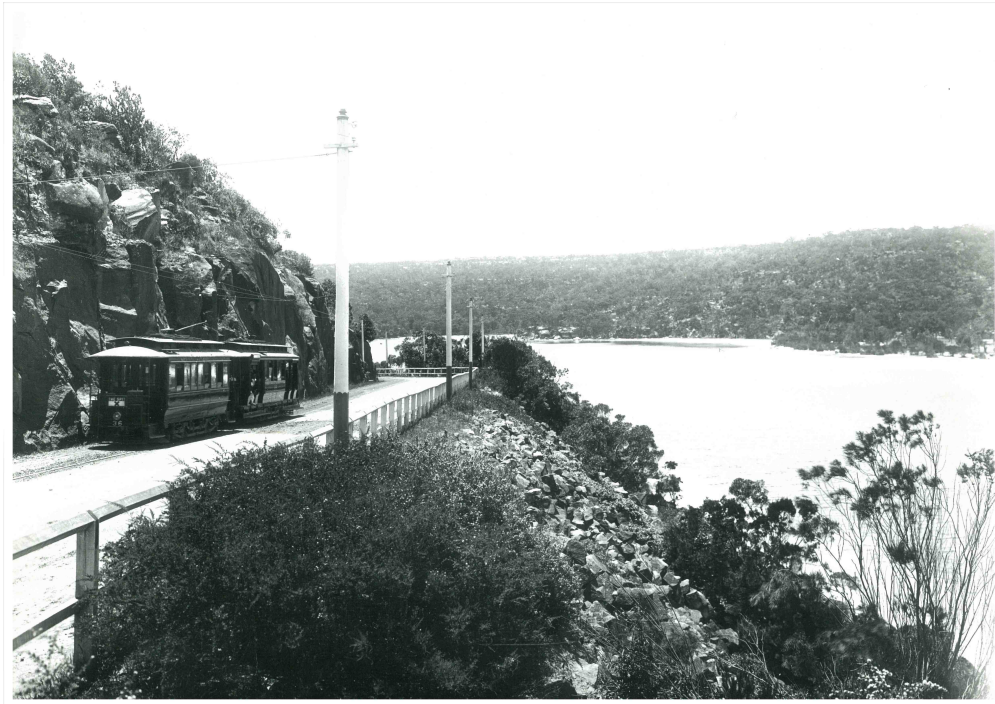

For a century from 1861 trams provided public transport for many parts of Sydney, including Mosman until 1958. Ron Besdansky's talk will cover a brief history of trams in Sydney generally before discussing the North Sydney system specifically with what he describes as 'all its idiosyncrasies'.
