Middle Head Officers' Quarters in 2019 (NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service)

Extensive conservation and restoration work is currently underway at Middle Head and Georges Head in Sydney Harbour National Park projects being undertaken by the NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service. They include the restoration and adaptive reuse of the significant Middle Head Officers' Quarters, construction of a new walking track linking the two precincts to neighboring parklands and interpretation to provide visitors with a better understanding of the stories that make the sites unique.

Robert Newton, Principal Project Officer, Greater Sydney Branch Major Infrastructure Delivery Team, NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service, has worked on Sydney Harbour fortification sites for more than 20 years. He will speak about the development of the impressive collection of fortifications at Middle Head and Georges Head, tell a few stories and provide an update on various cultural heritage projects.
