

Furl's Crochet Cuddly Bigfoot

MATERIALS

- [Furls 3.25 Odyssey Hook](#)

- Red Heart Super Saver Yarn (one skein of each color)

- 8mm safety eyes, stuffing, scissors, needle, black thread for eyebrows and mouth, wire brush if you want to brush out the belly patch and make it fuzzy.

Pattern

Head and Body (starting at the bottom of the body)

Rnd1: With the main color of your bigfoot sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: [Sc x 2, inc] x 6 (24)

Rnd5: [Sc x 3, inc] x 6 (30)

Rnd6: [Sc x 4, inc] x 6 (36)

Rnd7-10: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd11: [Sc x 4, dec] x 6 (30)

Rnd12-15: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd16: Dec x 15 (15)

Rnd17: Sc x 15 (15)

Rnd18: Inc x 15 (30)

Rnd19: [Sc, inc] x 15 (45)

Rnd20-21: Sc x 45 (45)

Rnd22: [Sc x 3, dec] x 9 (36)

Rnd23: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd24: Sc x 15, place your first safety eye in the last stitch you just did, sc x 2, place your second eye in the last stitch you just did, sc x 19 (36)

Rnd25: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd26: [Sc x 4, dec] x 6 (30)

Rnd27: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd28: [Sc x 3, dec] x 6 (24)

Rnd29: Sc x 24 (24)

Rnd30: [Sc x 2, dec] x 6, from this point on make sure you continue to stuff your bigfoot firmly (18)

Rnd31: Dec x 9 (9)

Rnd32: Dec x 4, sc (5)

Rnd33: Dec x 2 closed, and then fasten off (2)

Leg (make 2)

Rnd1: Ch x 7, join (7)

Rnd2-4: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd5: Inc, sc x 5 (7)

Rnd6: Sc x 7 (7)

Rnd7: Inc, sc x 3, inc, sc x 2 (9)

Rnd8: Sc x 9 (9)

Rnd9: Sc x 4, inc, sc x 3, inc (11)

Rnd10: Sc x 11 (11)

Rnd11: Sc x 3, inc, sc x 2, inc, sc x 3, inc (14)

Rnd12: Sc x 14 (14)

Rnd13: Sc x 4, inc, sc x 3, inc, sc x 4, inc, now fasten off (17)

Toe and thumb (make 8, three for each foot to use as toes, and two thumbs)

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2-3: Sc x 6, fasten off at the end of Rnd3 (6)

Bottom of foot and ear (make four of these two for the bottom of your feet and two to use as ears)

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6, now fasten off (12)

Belly Patch

Rnd1: Sc x 5 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 5sc in the second ch from your hook (5)

Rnd2-3: Sc x 5 (5)

Rnd4: Sc around the entire piece, now fasten off

Arm (make 2)

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc, sc x 5 (7)

Rnd3-8: Sc x 7 (7)

Rnd9: Dec, sc x 2m dec, sc (5)

Rnd10-14: Sc x 5, fasten off at the end of Rnd14 (5)

Horn (make 2)

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc x 2, dec] x 3 (9)

Rnd4: Sc x 9, fasten off

Scarf

Row1: Ch x 3 (3)

Row2-70: Sc x 2, fasten off at the end of Row70 (2)

Small snowball

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: [Inc, sc x 2] x 2 (8)

Rnd3: Sc x8 (8)

Rnd4: Stuff your snowball, dec x 4 (4)

Rnd5: Dec x 2, fasten off (2)

Large snowball

Rnd1: Sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: Sc x 12 (12)

Rnd4: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd5: [Sc, dec] x 6 (12)

Rnd6: Sc x 12 (12)

Rnd7: Stuff your snowball, dec x 6 (6)

Rnd8: Dec closed x 3, fasten off (3)

Assembly

Stuff your bigfoot firmly. Sew the bottoms of the feet onto the legs, stuff the legs and sew them onto your monster. Then sew on the arms, sew on the toes and thumbs onto your arms and legs. Fold the ears nearly in half and sew them onto your bigfoot's head along with the horns. If you would like the belly patch fuzzy sew it onto your bigfoot, then brush it with a wite brush. Weave in all ends and trim them.

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
