Yarn

A - Light Periwinkle

B - Yellow

Materials

Furls Odyssey Hook

Yarn needle

Stuffing

Abbreviations

ch-chain

sc-single crochet

inc-increase

dec-decrease

Size

Finished size is 10 inches



Head

Rnd1: Starting at the tip of your dragons nose with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4-5: Sc x 18 (18)

Rnd6: [Sc x 2, inc] x 6 (24)

Rnd7-10: Sc x 24 (24)

Rnd11: [Sc, inc] x 12 (36)

Rnd12: You will be placing the safety eyes in this round, sc x 15, place a safety eye in the last stitch you just did (or you can add a stitch marker and come back to add the eyes later. Also if you are wanting eyelashes you are going to want to sew them on before you attach your eyes), sc x 5, place the second safety eye in the last stitch you just did, sc x 16 (36)

Rnd13: [Sc x 2, inc] x 12 (48)

Rnd14-18: Sc x 48 (48)

Rnd19: Sc x 6, dec x 5, sc x 14, dec x 5, sc x 8 (38)

Rnd20: Sc x 38 (38)

Rnd 21: [Sc x 4, dec] x 6, sc x 2 (32)

Rnd22: Sc x 32 (32)

Rnd23: Dec x 16 (16)

Rnd24: Stuff the head firmly, dec x 8 (8)

Rnd25: Dec x 4 (4)

Rnd26: Dec x 2, and fasten off and weave in the end and trim

Ears

Make 2

Rnd1: Starting at the tip of the ear with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2-3: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd4: [Inc, sc] x 3 (9)

Rnd5-6: Sc x 9 (9)

Rnd7: Sc, [sc, inc] x 4 (13)

Rnd8: Sc x 13 (13)

Rnd9: Sc, [sc x 2, inc] x 4 (17)

Rnd10: Sc x 17, leave a long tail and fasten off (you will use the tail to sew the ears to your dragon) (17)

Horns

Make 2

Rnd1: Starting at the the tip of your dragons horn with B - Cornmeal Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2-5: Sc x 6, fasten off at the end of Rnd5 (6)

Nostrils & Eyelids

Make 4

Row1: With A - Light Blue Periwinkle Yarn ch x 6 (6)

Row2: Turn, sc x 5, leave a long tail and fasten off (you will use the tail to sew the eyelids and nostrils to your dragon)

Belly & Head Patch

Rnd1: Starting in the middle of the belly patch with B - Light Cornmeal Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: [Sc x 2, inc] x 6 (24)

Row5: You will now be working on Rows not in the Round, Turn, ch, sc x 6 (6)

Row6: Turn, ch, dec, sc x 2, dec (4)

Row7: Turn, ch, sc x 4 (4)

Row8: Turn, ch, dec x 2 (2)

Do not fasten off or turn, now sc around the entire piece and then fasten off

Row1: With B - Light Yellow Yarn ch x 3 (3)

Row2: Turn, sc x 2 (2)

Row3: Turn, ch, inc x 2 (4)

Row4-5: Turn, ch, sc x 4 (4)

Row6: Turn, ch, dec x 2, now you will fasten off (2)

Body

Rnd1: Starting at the the bottom of your dragon's body with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: Inc x 12 (24)

Rnd4: Sc x 24 (24)

Rnd5: (Sc, inc) x 12 (36)

Rnd6: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd7: (Sc x 2, inc) x 12 (48)

Rnd8-10: Sc x 48 (48)

Rnd11: Sc x 3, (sc x 7, dec) x 5 (43)

Rnd12: Sc x 43 (43)

Rnd13: Sc x 3, (sc x 3, dec) x 8 (35)

Rnd14-16: Sc x 35 (35)

Rnd17: (Sc x 5, dec) x 5 (30)

Rnd18-21: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd22: (Sc x 4, dec) x 5 (25)

Rnd23: Sc x 25, fasten off (25)

Legs

Make 2

Rnd1: Starting at the the bottom of your dragon's leg with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: Sc in back loop x 12 (12)

Rnd4-8: Sc x 12, fasten off at the end of Rnd8 (12)

Tail

Rnd1: Starting at the the tip of your dragon's tail with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2-4: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd5: Switch to (B) Yellow yarn and sc x 6 (6)

Rnd6: (Sc, inc) x 3 (9)

Rnd7: Sc, (sc, inc) x 4 (13)

Rnd8: Sc x 13 (13)

Rnd9: Switch to (A) Light Periwinkle Yarn and sc, (sc, inc) x 6 (19)

Rnd10-11: Sc x 19 (19)

Rnd12: Switch to (B) Yellow yarn and sc x 19 (19)

Rnd13: Sc x 2, (sc x 2, inc) x 5, sc x 2 (24)

Rnd14-16: Sc x 24 (24)

Rnd17: Change to (A) Light Periwinkle Yarn and sc x 24 (24)

Rnd18: (Sc x 3, inc) x 6 (30)

Rnd19: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd20: (Sc x4, inc) x 6 (36)

Rnd21: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd22: Change to (B) Yellow yarn and sc x 36 (36)

Rnd 23: (Sc x 5, inc) x 6 (42)

Rnd24-26: Sc x 42 (42)

Rnd27: (Sc x 5 , dec) x 6 (36)

Rnd28: Sc x 26 (26)

Rnd29: Change to (A) Light Periwinkle Yarn and sc x 36 (36)

Rnd30: Sc x 36, fasten off and leave a long tail.

Arms

Make 2

Rnd1: Starting at the the tip of your dragon's arm with A - Light Periwinkle Yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring (6). Or you can also ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6).

Rnd2: (Sc, inc) x 3 (9)

Rnd3-10: Sc x 9 (9)

Rnd11: Dec, sc x 7 (8)

Rnd12-13: Sc x 8 (8)

Rnd14: Dec, sc x 6 (7)

Rnd15-17: Sc x 7, fast off at the end of Rnd17 (7)

Wings

Row1: Starting at the tip of your wing with (B) Light Yellow yarn ch x 2 (2)

Row2: Turn, sc x 2 (2)

Row3: Turn, ch, sc x 2 (2)

Row4: Turn, ch, inc x 2 (4)

Row5-6: Turn, ch, sc x 4 (4)

Row7: Turn, ch, inc, sc x 2, inc (6)

Row8: Turn, ch, sc x 6 (6)

Row9: Turn, ch, inc, sc x 4, inc (8)

Row10: Turn, ch, sc x 8 (8)

Row11: Turn, ch, dec x 4 (4)

Row12: Turn, ch, sc x 4 (4)

Rnd13: Do not turn, sc around the entire piece, then fasten off.

Assembly

Stuff the head and weave in your end. Now sew the eyelids and nostrils onto your amigurumi. Sew on the ears, horns and head patch. Stuff the body, and sew it onto your dragon's head. I like to use dress making pins to hold the body in place.

Then stuff the legs and sew them onto the bottom of your dragon's body. Stuff the tail and sew in on to your body.



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
