



Yarn

Color A - 3 skeins of Lion Brand, LB Collection Cashmere, DK Weight - 25g/82yds - *Sample uses Toffee*

Color B - 4 skeins of Lion Brand, LB Collection Cashmere, DK Weight - 25g/82yds - *Sample uses Chocolate*

Materials

5.5mm I - Furls Alpha Series Wood Crochet Hook

Tapestry or yarn needle

Gauge (pre blocking)

16 sts and 8 rows dc = 4"

Size (blocked)

7" wide x 106" long



This infinity scarf is the ultimate in **luxury!** Crocheted in 100% Italian Cashmere, it's soft as a dream, and light as a cloud. It is wildly oversized, at 106" long, giving you endless styling options, and allowing you to wrap yourself in true indulgence.

Note:


The unused yarn can be carried up the side of the scarf to be covered with edging, or cut and woven in after every stripe.

Row 1: With Color A, ch 27, 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch-3 counts as dc), *skip next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch, skip next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch,** 3 dc in next ch; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **,turn. (24 sts)

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), *skip next 2 sts, (3 dc in next st) twice, skip next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts; repeat from * across, ending last repeat with 1 dc in the top of the ch-3, finishing the st with Color B, turn. (24 sts)

Row 3: With Color B, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in first st, *skip next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, skip next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st,** 3 dc in next st; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **,turn. (24)

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), *skip next 2 sts, (3 dc in next st) twice, skip next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts; repeat from * across, ending last repeat with 1 dc in the top of the ch-3, finishing the st with Color A, turn. (24 sts)



Rows 5 – 172: Repeat Rows 3 – 4, alternating colors every 2 rows. At the end of Row 172, break both yarns, leaving an 18” tail of Color B.

Finishing: Use the long tail of Color B to whip stitch Row 172 to Row 1, being careful not to twist the scarf. Weave in all ends. With Color B, work a round of sc along each side of the scarf, joining at the end of each round (344 sts per side). Wet block the scarf with cool water, laying flat to dry.
