

Furl's Crochet Girl and Boy Dolls

YARN

Red Heart Super Saver in your choice of colors
100-150 yards total per doll, including accessories and pets.

MATERIALS

3.5 (US G) Furls Odyssey hook
Stuffing

Head and Body

Worked as one piece in the round

Rnd1: Starting at the top of your ami's head with your choice of color of yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: Sc x 18 (18)

Rnd5: [Sc, inc] x 9 (27)

Rnd6-9: Sc x 27 (27)

Rnd10: [Sc x 5, inc] x 4, sc x 3 (31)

Rnd11: You will be placing the safety eyes in this round, sc x 12, place an eye in the last stitch you just did, sc x 4, place your second eye in the last stitch you just did, sc x 15 (31)

Rnd12-18: Sc x 31 (31)

Rnd19: Sc x 3, dec x 13, sc x 2 (18)

Rnd20: Stuff your doll as you are working, dec x 9 (9)

Rnd21-22: Sc x 9 (9)

Rnd23: Inc x 9 (18)

Rnd24: Sc x 18 (18)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch-chain

sc-single crochet

inc-increase

dec-decrease

Rnd25: [Sc x 5, inc] x 3 (21)

Rnd26-33: Sc x 21 (21)

Rnd34: Sc, [sc x 9, inc] x 2 (23)

Rnd35: Sc x 23 (23)

Rnd36: Sc, dec x 11 (12)

Rnd37: Dec x 6 (6)

Rnd38: Dec x 3, fasten off (3)

Arms (x2)

Rnd1: Starting at the tip of the hand with your choice of color of yarn sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6)

Rnd2-4: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd5: Dec, sc x 4 (5)

Rnd6-13: Sc x 5, fasten off at the end of Rnd13 (5)

Ears and Nose

Ear (make 2)

Rnd1: With your choice of color of yarn sc x 5 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 5sc in the second chain from your hook (5)

Rnd2: Inc x 5, fasten off (10)

Nose

Row1: With your choice of color of yarn ch x 2 (2)

Rnd2: Bobble/puff stitch in the second chain from your hook, fasten off (1)

Legs and Feet

Leg (make 2)

Rnd1: Starting at the top of your leg with the yarn color of your choosing ch x 7, join (7)

Rnd2-3: Sc x 7 (7)

Rnd4: Dec, sc x 5 (6)

Rnd5-15: Sc x 6 (6)

Row16: Now you will be starting the foot, Sc x 2 (2)

Row17-18: Turn, ch , sc x 1 (2)

Rnd19: Do not turn, simply sc around the entire piece, fasten off

Sole of foot (make 2)

Row1: With the color of yarn of your choosing ch x 3 (3)

Row2: Turn, sc x 2 (2)

Row3-6: Turn, ch, sc x 2, fasten off at the end of Row6 (2)

Assembly

Make sure your dolls body is stuffed firmly, weave in ends and trim it. Stuff the leg, and sew the sole onto the bottom of your foot. Then sew the leg onto the body. Sew the arms, ears and nose onto your doll. Then I like to use cross stitching thread and embroider on a mouth and eyebrows. Weave in all of your ends and trim them. Now you have a new little friend!

Now it's time to make the accessories!

Girl's Accessories

Girl's Hair

Rnd1: With yarn in the color of your choosing sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: Inc x 12 (24)

Rnd4: Sc x 24 (24)

Rnd5: [Sc x inc] x 12 (36)

Rnd6-17: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd18: [Sc x 4, dec] x 6 (30)

Row19: Do not turn your work, you will be starting the bangs in this round, sc x 20 (20)

Row20: Turn, ch, inc, [sc x 4, inc] x 3, sc x 3 inc (25)

Row21-25: Turn, ch, sc x 25 (25)

Row26: Turn, ch, inc x 2, sc x 21, inc x 2 (29)

Row27: Turn, ch, sc x 29, fasten off (29)

Dress

Row1: With yarn in the color of your choosing ch x 21 (21)

Row2: Turn, sc x 20 (20)

Row3: Turn, ch, [inc, sc x 4] x 4 (24)

Row4-8: Turn, ch, sc x 24 (24)

Row9: Turn, ch, [sc x 3, inc] x 6 (30)

Row10: Turn, ch, [sc x 4, inc] x 6 (36)

Row11-14: Turn, ch, sc x 36 (36)

Row15: In this last round of the dress you will be created the frilly edging, ch x 3, sc in the first stitch, [skip stitch, sc, ch x 3, sc, all in the next stitch] x 17 , sc , fasten off (36)

Shoulder strap

Row1: Ch x 10 (10)

Row2: Turn, sc x 9, fasten off (9)

Hair Bow

Row1: With the yarn color of your choosing ch x 10 (10)

Row2: Turn, sc x 9 (9)

Row3-7: Turn, ch, sc x 9 (9)

Rnd8: Do not turn, sc around the entire piece and fasten off

Boy's Accessories

Rnd1: With yarn in the color of your choosing sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3-5: Sc x 12 (12)

Row6-11: Now you will switch and you will be working in rows no longer working in the round, turn, ch, sc x 9, fasten off at the end of Row11 (9)

Shirt

Row1: With yarn in the color of your choosing ch x 30 (30)

Row2: Turn, sc x 29 (29)

Row3: Turn, ch, sc x 29 (29)

Row4: Turn, ch, dec x 2, sc x 21, dec x 2 (25)

Row5-7: Turn, ch, sc x 25 (25)

Row8: Turn, ch, dec, sc x 3, now you are making the opening for the arm hole, ch x 5, skip 3 stitches, sc x 9, ch x 5, skip three stitches, sc x 3, dec (16)

Row9: Turn, ch, sc x 4, sc x 4 in the ch5 space, sc x 9, sc x 4 in ch 5 space, sc x 4, fasten off (25)

Shorts

Row1: With yarn in the color of your choosing ch x 26, join (26)

Rnd2-7: Sc x 26 (26)

Rnd8: You will be creating the first leg opening in the shorts now, skip 13 stitches, sc x 13 (13)

Rnd9-11: Sc x 13, fasten off at the end of Rnd11 (13)

Second short leg

Rnd1: Insert your hook into the first stitch to the left beside the first short leg and sc x 13 around (13)

Rnd2-4: Sc x 13, fasten off at the end of Rnd4 (13)

Hat

Rnd1: With yarn in the color of your choosing, sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and sc x 6 in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: [Sc, inc] x 9 (27)

Rnd5: Sc x 27 (27)

Rnd6: [Sc x 2, inc] x 9 (36)

Rnd7: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd8: In the front loops [sc x 4, dec] x 6 (30)

Rnd9-12: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd13: Now you will be making the bill on the hat, turn, ch, sc in the back loop x 9 (9)

Rnd14-15: Turn, ch, sc x 19 (19)

Row16: Turn, ch, dec x 2, sc, dec x 2 (5)

Rnd17: sc around the entire piece, fasten off

Backpack

Row1: With yarn in the color of your choosing ch x 9 (9)

Row2: Turn, sc x 8 (8)

Row3: Sc down the opposite side of your work x 8 (8)

Rnd4-12: Sc around the entire piece x 16 (16)

Row13: Now you will be making the closure sc x 4 (4)

Row14-21: Turn, ch, sc x 5 (5)

Rnd22: Do not turn, sc around the entire piece, then fasten off.

Backpack Strap (make 2)

Row1: Ch x 19 (19)

Row2: Turn, slip stitch x19 , fasten off (19)

Assembly

Sew the backs of the shoes closed. Put the shirt on your doll and sew the backing closed. Weave in the ends on these items along with the ends on your shorts and hat. Sew the straps onto your backpack. If you made the dress, put it on your doll and sew the back closed. Put the hair on your doll along with the bow and sew them in place. Now your new best friend is complete, they just need their little pet sidekick!

Pets

Head

Rnd1: Starting in the middle of the face of your lion sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second chain from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: [Sc x 2, inc] x 6 (24)

Rnd5: Sc in the back loop x 24 (24)

Rnd6: [Sc x 4, dec] x 4 (20)

Rnd7-9: Sc x 20 (20)

Rnd10: Dec x 10 (10)

Rnd11: Stuff the head firmly as you are working, Dec x 5 (5)

Rnd12: Dec x 2, sc (3)

Rnd13: Dec, sc, fasten off (2)

Body

Rnd1: Starting at the neck, ch x 8, join (8)

Rnd2: Sc x 8 (8)

Rnd3: inc x 8 (16)

Rnd4-6: Sc x 16 (16)

Rnd7: Dec x 8 (8)

Rnd8: Stuff the body as you are working, dec x 4 (4)

Rnd9: Dec x 2 closed, fasten off (2)

Ear (Make 2)

Rnd1: Starting in the tip of your ear sc x 5 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 5sc in the second chain from your hook (5)

Rnd2: Sc x 5, fasten off (5)

Mane

Rnd1: Insert your hook into one of the front loops in Rnd5 of your lions head, [skip stitch, sc x 2 and slip stitch all in the next loop] x 9, fasten off (27)

Assembly

Stuff the body and the head of your little pet. Now sew the body onto the head. Sew on the ears. Weave in all ends and trim them. Now sew on eyes, a nose and mouth. That's it, you now have a fun little pet sidekick for your little doll!

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
