YARN & MATERIALS

Vannas Choice in Mustard
Vannas Choice in Brown
Vannas Choice in Scarlett
Vannas Choice in Violet
Vannas Choice in Kelly Green
Vannas Choice in Terracotta (Orange)
Darning needle
Fiber fill & Scissors

4mm Furls Forest Odyssey Hook



Notes:

This entire piece will be worked in continuous rounds, so it will be helpful to have a stitch marker so you don't lose your place. For the border, you will be working the Crab Stitch.

Abbreviations:

Sc- single crochet
Inc- Increase (2 sc in same stitch)
Dec- Decrease
*- repeat around the row
()- number of stitches at the end of the round

Pattern

Start from the tip of the Cornucopia:

Begin in Brown

Rnd 1: Sc 4 into Magic Ring (4)
Rnd 2: Sc around (4)
Rnd 3: *Sc, Inc* around (6)
Rnd 4: Sc around (6)
Rnd 5: *Sc 2, Inc* around (8)
Rnd 6: Sc around (8)
Rnd 7: *Sc 3, Inc* around (10)
Rnd 8: Sc around (10)
Rnd 9: *Sc 4, Inc* around (12)
Rnd 10: Sc around (12)
Rnd 11: *Sc 5, Inc* around (14)
Rnd 12: *Sc 6, Inc* around (16)
Rnd 13: *Sc 7, Inc* around (18)
Rnd 14: *Sc 8, Inc* around (20)

Rnd 15: *Sc 9, Inc* around (22)
Rnd 16: *Sc 10, Inc* around (24)
Rnd 17: *Sc 3, Inc* around (30)
Rnd 18: Sc around (30)
Rnd 19: *Sc 4, Inc* around (36)
Rnd 20: Sc around (36)
Rnd 21: *Sc 5, Inc* around (42)
Rnd 22: Sc around (42)
Rnd 23: *Sc 6, Inc* around (48)
Rnd 24: Sc around (48)
Rnd 25: *Sc 7, Inc* around (54)
Rnd 26: Sc around (54)
Rnd 27: *Sc 8, Inc* around (60)
Rnd 28: Sc around (60)
Rnd 29: *Sc 9, Inc* around (66)
Rnd 30: Sc around (66)

Now, we will be doing the crab stitch to create the border!



You will now Ch 1, and you will do a sc into the stitch BEHIND your current one, seen below:



You will continue going backwards for the remainder of this round, and it will look like this!



Starting in Orange

Rnd 1: Single Crochet 6 into Magic Ring (6)

Rnd 2: *Inc* around (12)

Rnd 3: *Sc, Inc* around (18)

Rnd 4: *Sc 2, Inc* around (24)

Rnd 5: *Sc 3, Inc* around (30)

Rnd 6: *Sc 4, Inc* around (36)

Rnd 7-10: Sc around (30)

Rnd 11: *Sc 4, Dec* around (24)

Rnd 12: *Sc 3, Dec* around (18)

Rnd 13: *Sc 2, Dec* around (12)

Insert the hook through 2 loops at a time and pull to close the hole!
Take the end of the yarn and pull through the center VERY tightly.





Take the end of the yarn and pull through the center VERY tightly.



Do this around 5 more times (6 in total)

Now lets create the stem!

Rnd 1: 6 Single Crochet into the Magic Ring (6)

Rnd 2-3: Sc around (6)

Finish off and leave tail

Now sew the stem into the middle!

Creating the vine

Pull your green yarn through a stitch closest to the stem



Ch 8.

In second chain from hook, sc twice into that chain. 2 Inc in each stitch across. (It will begin curling!)

Cut your yarn and weave it in!

Now for the leaf:

Rnd 1: Sc 6 into Magic Ring (6)

Rnd 2: *Inc* around (12)

Rnd 3: *Sc, Inc* around (18)

Rnd 4-8: Sc around (18)

Rnd 9: *Sc, Dec* around (12)

Rnd 10: Sc around (12)

Rnd 11: *Dec* around (6)

Rnd 12: Sc around (6)

Leave flat and do not stuff so you can embroider the detail on!



Creating the apple:

Rnd 1: Single Crochet 6 into Magic Ring (6)

Rnd 2: *Inc* around (12)

Rnd 3: *Sc, Inc* around (18)

Rnd 4: *Sc 2, Inc* around (24)

Rnd 5: *Sc 3, Inc* around (30)

Rnd 6: *Sc 4, Inc* around (36)

Rnd 7-10: Sc around (30)

Rnd 11: *Sc 4, Dec* around (24)

Rnd 12: *Sc 3, Dec* around (18)

Rnd 13: *Sc 2, Dec* around (12)

With your body of the apple complete, take your yarn needle and pull through the center.

Pull tight so there becomes an indent on the top.

To create the stem, insert your hook in the center stitches and pull your yarn through.

In second chain from hook, sc across to the apple body.

Grapes (Make 5)

Begin in Purple.

Rnd 1: Single Crochet 6 into Magic Ring (6)

Rnd 2: *Inc* around (12)

Rnd 3: Sc around (12)

Rnd 4: *Dec* around (6)

Finish off and fill.





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
