YARN

Red Heart Super Value Yarn 364 yards

MATERIALS

- 8mm safety eyes
- Stuffing, scissors and a sewing needle, black embroidery thread for the mouth and eyebrows
- [E/3.5mm Blue Odyssey Hook](#)

Pattern

The Body

Rnd1: With the main color of your narwhal sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: [Sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Rnd4: [Sc, inc] x 9 (27)

Rnd5: Sc x 27 (27)

Rnd6: [Sc x 2, inc] x 9 (36)

Rnd7-8: Sc x 36 (36)

Rnd9: *You will be placing the safety eyes in this round.* [Sc x 5, inc] x 2, sc, place eye in the last stitch, sc x 4, inc, sc x 5, inc, sc, place eye in the last stitch, sc x 4, inc, sc x 5, inc (42)

Rnd10-12: Sc x 42 (42)

Rnd13: Sc, [sc x 4, inc] x 8, sc (50)

Rnd14: Sc x 50 (50)

Rnd15: [Sc x 3, dec] x 10 (40)

Rnd16-17: Sc x 40 (40)

Rnd18: [Sc x 6, dec] x 5 (35)

Rnd19-21: sc x 35 (35)

Rnd22: [Sc x 5, dec] x 5 (30)

Rnd23: Sc x 30 (30)

Rnd24: [Sc x 4, dec] x 5 (25)

Rnd25-26: Sc x 25 (25)

Rnd27: [Sc x 3, dec] x 5 (20)

Rnd28: Sc x 20 (20)

Rnd29: [Sc x3, dec] x 4 (16)

Rnd30: Sc x 16 (16)

Rnd31: [Sc x 2, dec] x 4 (12)

Rnd32: Sc x 12 (12)

Rnd33: *Stuff your narwhal firmly,* [sc, dec] x 4 (8)

Rnd34-37: Sc x 8 (8)

Rnd38: Dec x 4, fasten off (4)

Fin (make 2)

Rnd1: With the main color of your narwhal sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6 (12)

Rnd3: Sc x 12 (12)

Rnd4: [Sc x 4, dec] x 2 (10)

Rnd5: [Sc, dec] x 3, sc (7)

Rnd6-7: Sc x 7, fasten off at the end of Rnd7 (7)

Tail Fin (make 2)

Rnd1: With the main color of your narwhal sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2-3: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd4: [Inc, sc] x 3 (9)

Rnd5-6: Sc x 9, fasten off at the end of Rnd6 (9)

Horn

Rnd1: With the color yarn that you would like to use for the horn sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2-4: Sc x 6 (6)

Rnd5: [Inc, sc x 2] x 2 (8)

Rnd6: Sc x 8 (8)

Rnd7: [Inc, sc x 3] x 2 (10)

Rnd8: Sc x 10, fasten off (10)

Large Circle

Rnd1: With the color yarn that you would like to use for your circle sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook (6)

Rnd2: Inc x 6, fasten off (12)

Small Circle

Rnd1: With the color yarn that you would like to use for the horn sc x 6 in a magic ring, or ch x 2 and do 6sc in the second ch from your hook, fasten off (6)

Assembly

Sew the fins onto your narwhal, and onto each side at the end of the tail. I use dress making pins to hold the fins in place until I sew a portion of them on. Sew on a mouth and eyebrows. Stuff the horn and sew it onto your Narwhal along with the circles.
