#### **HYPERSENSITIVITY**

It is a well-known fact that certain individuals for undetermined reasons, may be allergic to or hypersensitive to foods, drugs, cosmetics and other substances or materials that are harmless to most people. The relatively few people who are subject to such reactions are said to be allergic or hypersensitive.


### PERFORM A SKIN SENSITIVITY TEST 48 HOURS BEFORE EVERY APPLICATION.

To ascertain whether you are hypersensitive or allergic to this product you must make the skin sensitivity test 48 before application.

- 1. Prepare the test mixture by mixing a small quantity as directed.
- Apply a small amount of the mixture to a previously washed area on the inner fold of the elbow.
- Allow the test area to dry and leave uncovered and undisturbed for
  48 hours.

During or immediately after the 48-hour period, if any burning, swelling, redness or irritation shows in or around the area then it must be assumed that you are allergic to the product and must not use it.

This product must not be applied to the lashes or hairs if the skin nearby shows evidence of any abrasion or soreness.



#### **WARNING:**

This product contains ingredients which may cause skin irritation to certain individuals and when used for eyelash and eyebrow dyeing may cause injury to the eye. A preliminary test according to the following directions should be made before use.

#### **SAFETY DIRECTIONS:**

- Do not use if you have ever experienced any allergic reaction to a hair colourant.
- Do not use if your eyes are currently sore, irritated or if the skin around the eyes is broken.
- Do not use on eyebrows that have been plucked and/or waxed during the last 72 hours.
- Perform a skin sensitivity test 48 hours before dyeing your lashes or brows.
- Developer liquid contains hydrogen peroxide.
- Avoid contact with the eyes. If the product gets into the eyes, rinse immediately with cold water. If irritation persists, seek medical advice,

- Not be taken internally

Eye protection papers are included in the kit but if you run out, use paper towelling and trace out two eye-pads and cut into shape as traced.

#### THINGS YOU NEED:

- 1. Dish of cold water
- 2. Petroleum Jelly (Vaseline)
- 3. Cotton pads
- 4. Cotton buds

#### PREPARE INSTRUCTIONS

#### Prepare eye and brow area

- Remove natural oils and make up with a non-oily cleanser from lashes and brows.
- 2. **Lashes:** Take two eye protection papers and apply Vaseline on one side of the paper. Place and press the papers underneath the eyes and adhere to the skin as close as possible to the bottom lashes. (See diagram below).
- Brows: Apply Vaseline with a cotton bud around the brow to protect the skin from coming in contact with the dye.
- Squeeze a 2.5cm strip of the colour cream into the mixing cup. Add ten drops of the developer liquid and mix together using the white wand provided.

Use the white wand to mix the colour cream and developer liquid together. You can use the white wand to apply the eyelash/brow mixture or alternatively, you can use the spoolie to apply the dye.



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

# When applying to someone else.

- 5. Lying down with eyes closed, apply the dye using the white wand or spoolie in the same manner as applying mascara i.e. Upwards strokes catching bottom lashes and the tips of the top lashes. Followed by downwards strokes to the top lashes.
- Keeping eyes closed, allow ten minutes for the dye to develop. Avoid opening eyes as this may cause irritation.
- Keeping eyes closed, use a dampened cotton pad to gently remove remaining dye. Use downward strokes first then upwards strokes.
- 8. Remove eye protection papers, eyes can now be opened. Use cotton pad to remove Vaseline or remaining dye.

## BROWS

For colouring brows and other hairs follow the same instructions leaving the mixture on for about six minutes. Then gently removing the dye with a damp cotton pad.



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### When applying to yourself.

- Apply the dye using the white wand or spoolie in the same manner as applying mascara. Leave the dye to develop for ten minutes.
- Remove the remaining dye by closing eyes and wiping gently with a damp cotton pad.

#### **IMPORTANT**

A slight tingling sensation may occur, this is a normal reaction. However, burning, swelling, redness or irritation is not. Avoid getting mixture in the eyes. If this occurs, immediately flush with cold water.

If you are using the same colour for lashes and brows, you can use the same applicator wand. If you decide to use a lighter colour for the brows, use a clean mixing cup and applicator.







Dispose of product 12 months after first use.
