## FIND YOUR FIT GUIDE

Finding your ideal ring size helps ensure that you can wear your ring comfortably with confidence so you can shine bright.

## STEP 1: Confirm Paper Guide Size

Before measuring your ring, use a ruler to check that the printed paper size is correct.
Use the measurement box on the right to ensure the printed scale is accurate. When printing, be sure to set the scale to $100 \%$ in your print settings.

The printout measurement of 2 inches $/ 50 \mathrm{~mm}$ long must match a ruler's measurements exactly. If this is not accurate, you will not be able to properly measure your ring.


## STEP 2: Measure With Your Current Ring

1. Use one of your existing rings that correctly fits the specific finger you're looking to size.
2. Using the ring size chart (above), lay your ring over the circle(s) closest in size.
3. Align the inside edge of the ring with the edge of the circle.

## HELPFUL HINTS

- If a ring is between two sizes, we recommend ordering the larger size.
- Engagement and wedding rings are commonly worn on the left ring finger in the United States.
