
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
SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do no turn up the volume to an excessively high level. Extended exposure to high-decibel sounds may cause permanent hearing loss.
- Do not turn up the volume so high that you can't hear what's around you or respond to potentially hazardous situations.
- Do not use earbuds while driving or cycling, which could hinder traffic safety.
- Do not immerse earbuds in water.
- Do not pull on the cords to remove the ear tips from your ears. Instead, gently remove the ear tips with your fingers.
- Do not expose earbuds to extreme heat or direct sunlight for extended periods.

CHARGING THE RANGER BLUETOOTH EARBUDS

The Ranger Bluetooth Earbuds battery lasts for approximately 8+ hours of talk time or play time per charge.

1. Connect the small end of the micro USB charging cable to the micro USB port on the earbuds.

2. Connect the large end of the micro USB charging cable to the USB charging port on an AC charger, wall outlet, or laptop. The LED indicator will remain RED during the charging process.

3. Disconnect the cable from the earbuds and the charging port once charging is complete. The earbuds take approximately 1 hour to fully recharge.

Note: Select devices support a battery readout meter feature, which shows the remaining battery life of the Bluetooth-connected device. Check your device's user guide to see if this feature is supported.

PAIRING THE RANGER BLUETOOTH EARBUDS

The Ranger Bluetooth Earbuds connect to Bluetooth-enabled devices with version 4.0 or higher. In order to pair the earbuds to your device, follow the directions below:

1. Press and hold the power button until a voice is heard which indicates the earbuds are now in pairing mode. The LED indicator will alternately flash blue and red.

2. Set your device to search for Bluetooth devices.

3. Open the Bluetooth feature on your device. Consult your device's user guide for more information.

4. Select "Ranger" from the list of devices in the populated list.

5. If asked, enter the password "0000."

6. after paired, blue LED will flash every 10 sec

7. Hold the power button for 4 seconds to turn off the earbud.

CONNECTING TO MULTIPLE DEVICES

These earbuds have a multi-connection feature, which connects the earbuds to two devices simultaneously. In order to activate this feature, follow these steps:

1. While paired to your first device, press and hold the volume up and volume down buttons simultaneously for 5 seconds to disconnect from your first device.

2. Then the LED indicator will alternately flash blue and red to enter pairing mode again

3. Follow the directions in "Pairing the Ranger to a device" to pair to the second device.

4. Using your first device to connect the earbud again without disconnecting from the second device.

Note: In multi-connection mode, the earbuds will receive calls from one device and audio from the other.

PLAYING MUSIC ON YOUR RANGER BLUETOOTH EARBUDS

Playing: Press the power button to begin playing.

Pause: Press the power button to pause the music.

Resume: Press the power button again to resume playback.

Adjusting volume

Press and hold the volume up button to increase the volume. Press and hold the volume down button to decrease the volume. Note: Volume can also be controlled directly from the connected device.

Navigating a playlist

Press the volume + button to skip to the next song. Press the volume - button to return to the last song.

MANAGING PHONE CALLS ON YOUR RANGER BLUETOOTH EARBUDS

To accept, mute or reject a phone call: press the power button to accept an incoming phone call.

To end a phone call: press the power button to end the call.

To mute an existing call: During a phone call double press the power button to mute call; press again to unmute.

To reject an incoming phone call: Double press the power button to reject an incoming phone call.

To accept a second incoming call: Press the power button to accept a second incoming call. Note: your first call will automatically be placed on hold once you accept a second incoming call.

To reject a second incoming call: Press and hold the power button for approximately 2 seconds to reject a second incoming call.

To transfer calls between Bluetooth and phone: When in a call, press the power button for one second to transfer to the mobile phone, press again for one second to transfer back to headphone

To disconnect the Bluetooth from the phone: Only when music is paused, press and hold both volume + and volume – buttons together for 4 seconds

3rd party calling

In the call, press the power button to answer the new incoming call and end the current call

- Double press the power button to answer the new incoming call and hold the current call
- Double press the power button to switch back to 2nd party call and hold the 3rd party call

CONNECT WITH TWO BLUETOOTH DEVICES

First connect device A to the headset, after connected, turn off the Bluetooth function of device A, then connect the device B to the headset, and turn on the Bluetooth of device A again, auto-reconnect or reconnect the device A with headset again, after connected, the headset is connecting to two devices.

Answer the call of 2nd connected phone	Short press the power button	When phone A in the call, incoming call to phone B, short press to end call of phone A and answer the call of phone B
Hold the call of phone A and answer incoming call of phone B	Double press the power button	When phone A in the call, incoming call to phone B, double press to hold the call of phone A and answer incoming call of phone B
Switch	Double press the power button	When call of phone A is holding, phone B in the call, double press to resume call of phone A and hold the call of phone B
End current call and resume the holding call	Short press power button	When call of phone A is holding, phone B in the call, short press the end the call of phone B and resume the call of phone A

USING YOUR EARBUDS WITH DIGITAL PERSONAL ASSISTANTS

The Ranger earbuds can access voice-activated search functions such as Siri on Apple products.

Double-press the power button in order to activate the device's digital personal assistant. For apple products just say "Hey Siri" and it will turn on the command.

Double-press the power button to end the session.

Note: Pause music before attempting to activate a digital personal assistant.

PROTECTING YOUR EARS IN NOISY ENVIRONMENTS

The Ranger Bluetooth Earbuds have an EPA noise-reduction rating.

It's important to note that this number is a benchmark guideline. Because each person's ears are unique in shape and hearing sensitivity, the actual amount of noise reduction experienced with the earbuds varies from person to person.

The Ranger Bluetooth Earbuds come with Flexfoam ear tips, which are particularly effective at blocking ambient noise because they expand to fit snugly in the ear canal.

CHANGING EAR TIPS

The Ranger Bluetooth Earbuds come with Flexfoam[™] ear tips and triple flange ear tips. Flexfoam ear tips provide maximum noise reduction, while triple flange ear tips provide an accurate and secure fit inside the ear.

To change the ear tips:

1. Gently twist the old ear tip until it comes off the earbuds.

2. Place the ear tip's cylindrical opening on the earbud's driver stem.

3. Gently twist the ear tip downward into place until it fully covers the driver stem.

Note: Do not yank the ear tips off the earbuds. This may damage your earbuds.
