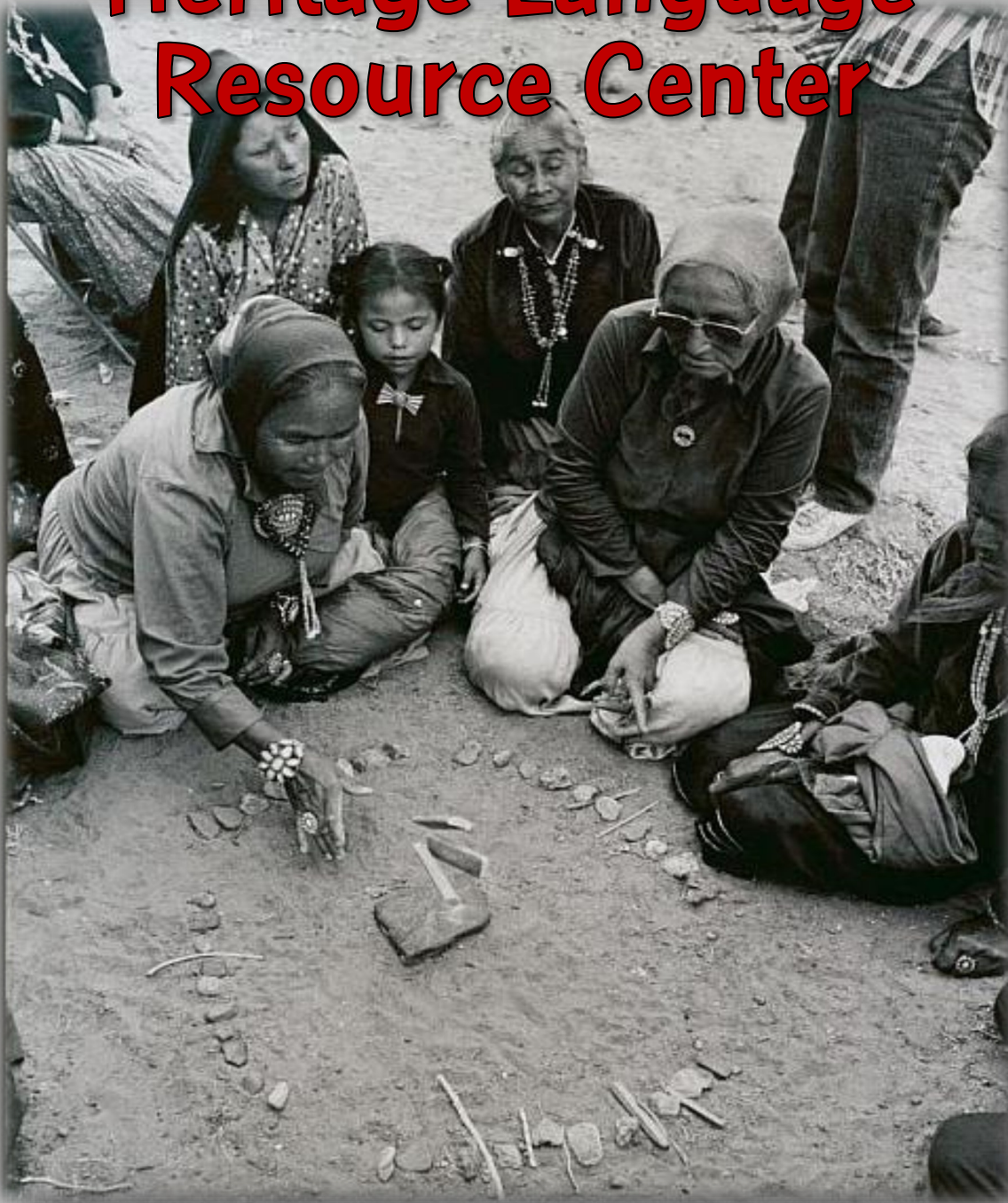

When we upset a balance here, it usually affects something else where it results in a threat to our well-being.

To the EAST, dawn, Spring, Mt. Blanca and standards for living were put in place for a purpose.

The first knowledge inherent in the dawn is *bik'e'ngo dá'Ináanii* (that which gives direction to life) emphasizing character development and excellence of the heart and mind. All knowledge that will help an individual make intelligent decisions whenever a choice in value is to be made is associated with this light, so it is this knowledge which brings clarity and perspective to the mind and permeates every facet of one's life: work, social existence and his relationship with nature. In the absence of this knowledge, standards of behavior will be absent, which may result in greed and social maladjustment, leading toward degradation and destruction.

To the WEST, twilight, autumn, San Francisco Peak and family cohesiveness were put in place for a purpose. The knowledge associated with the west centers on *h'e' hodinidzin* (positive human relations). This type of learning originated within the home where kinship terms rather than names are generally used to address family members. The use of appropriate kinship terms between siblings reinforces positive family ties, the knowledge of and the use of the clan system in our tribe is very precious. The interpersonal relationships learned in the home are lived out in the community. How one interacts with others in his community, his cooperative attitude and the respect that he shows his leaders all come from the home.

To the SOUTH, blue horizon, summer, Mt. Taylor and a means of travel was put in place for a purpose. *Ak'Ina'adl'idáso'ádl'i'idi* (to provide for oneself and maintain dignity), the second branch of knowledge placed in the South, encourages one to achieve self-sufficiency and dignity. To achieve this goal one must recognize work in all its dimensions. Work has an ethical and social dimension and an impact on the environment. A part of the work dimension is the awareness of moderation and excessiveness as a basic concern in Navajo philosophy. To take anything into excess is harmful and evil. To insure one's internal balance, he must not forget his environment and his people, the source of power and strength.

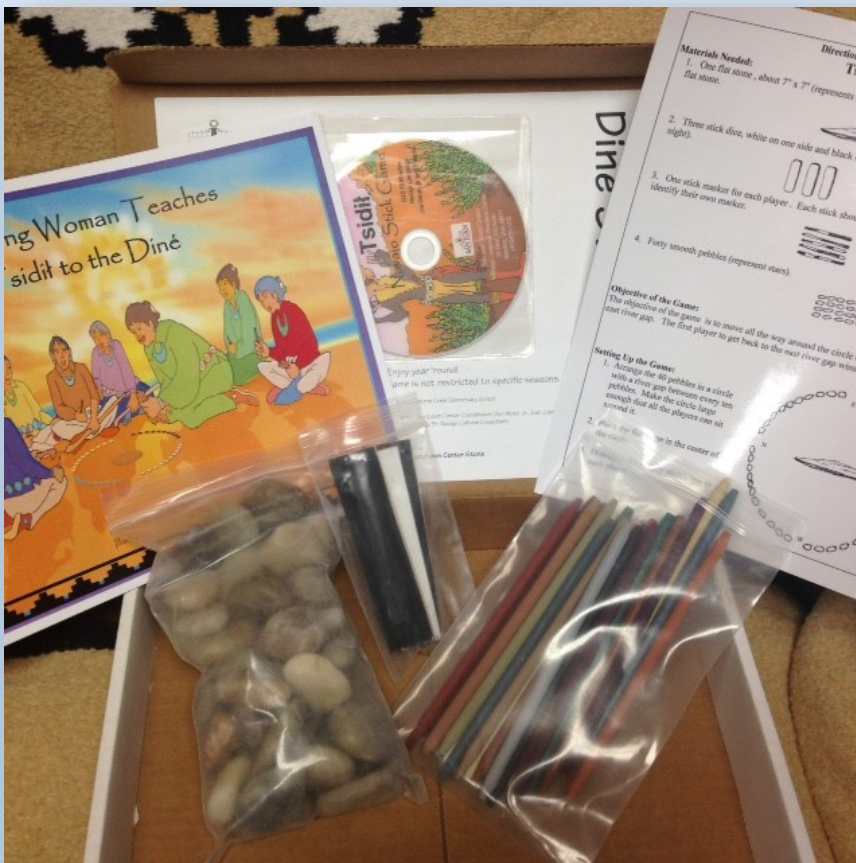
About the Stick Game

The Stick Game is a traditional activity given to the First Diné Clans by Changing Woman. Since it is not seasonally-specific, this game can be played anytime of the year. Inside the box are 40 stones that represent stars, three black and white “dice” (represent night & day), 25 painted wooden sticks for markers (each player gets one), a 10-minute DVD of Stick Game songs, and playing demonstration, a 16-page, full color, spiral-bound booklet, and instruction sheet.

*Heavy stones have now been replaced with colored glass “buttons” that represent the Four Directions. The glass buttons are lighter for shipping and fun for the students.

** We do not include the “Mother Earth” center stone as including it in the box would increase weight & shipping cost.

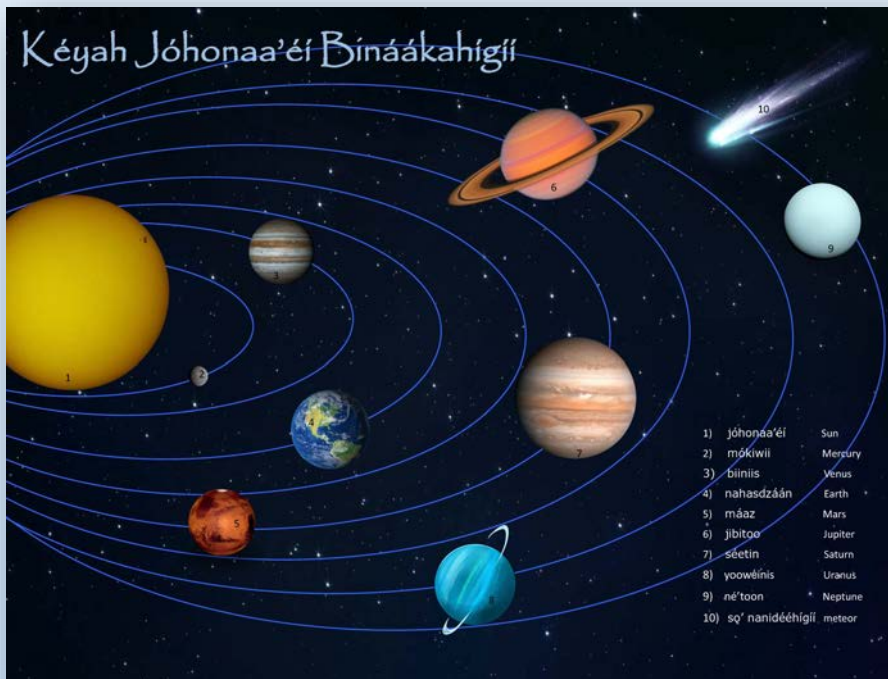
