CHARACTERISTICS:

Also known as sueded or brushed leather, nubuck is produced by aniline-dyeing the hides in the drum, lightly brushing the surface to produce their iconic nappy effect, and then tumbling to bring out the natural texture of the hides. Prized for its soft, inviting feel, Nubuck is the ultimate in comfy, cozy leather. Rugged enough to be used for boots and shoes, it has remarkable versatility.



CARE & CLEANING:

Nubuck should be vacuumed with a clean, soft bristle attachment. Use a suede brush or slightly damp hard nylon sponge to clean and straighten the fine pile when necessary. Spilled liquids should be removed immediately by dabbing with a clean cloth (do not rub). Nubuck leather cleaners may be used according to the manufacturer's instructions after first testing in an inconspicuous place. For difficult stains, it is always best to contact a specialist as damage may occur due to improper cleaning.

For optimum performance and longevity, do not place your leather furniture within twelve inches of a heating source or in sustained direct sunlight.

A NOTE ON NUBUCK:

Nubuck is an aniline leather that is sanded to create the beautiful, soft texture of suede. Like all aniline leathers, nubuck displays the natural beauty of the hide, including neck wrinkles, stretch marks, spines, insect bites, and scars. As with stained natural hardwoods, leather shows shading variation in and between hides. These characteristics are part of the leather's beauty and are not considered defects.
