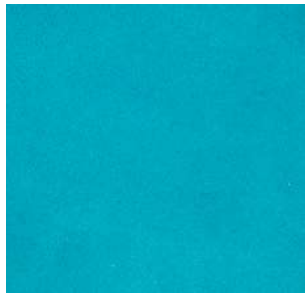

CARE & CLEANING:

Velours is durable, yet delicate to the touch; it is best suited for light upholstery use.

Velours should be vacuumed regularly with a soft, dry bristle brush. Fresh stains should be gently wiped or blotted with a clean cloth and lukewarm water.

For difficult stains, it is always best to contact a specialist as damage can easily occur due to improper cleaning.

For optimum performance and longevity, do not place your leather furniture within twelve inches of a heating source or in sustained direct sunlight.
