■ How to connect the camera


Connect one end of the micro USB cable to the USB connector provided on the board of B0196, and connect the other end to the USB host controller on the computer. Then the light of its power indicator on the back will be on.

4. How to use the program (Windows demo only)

The Menu bar on top of the shown image contains a few menu items. The current preview resolution and the frame rate are displayed on the bottom bar when the application is running. The following sections describe each of the menu items in detail.

■ Menu>Devices
