What's New from GenOn?

Cohorts for smaller churches: Our Growth Groups provide online training for smaller churches to receive training, support, and encouragement in trying new directions for strengthening intentional intergenerational community.

Intergenerational training for all churches: A series of guided sessions for a team of church leaders to design their own approach to deepen intergenerational community in a chosen ministry area—Worship, Study, Service, or Fellowship.

Support for families: A planning project is helping us dream of new ways to support church leaders to support parents in faith formation of their children.

Our Volunteers

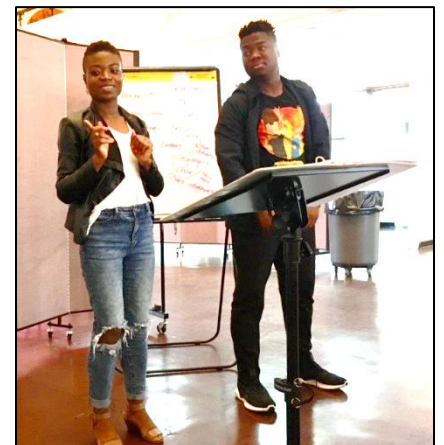
