Total score: 9 or less:

Mild Symptoms (similar to the horse, Clooney, in the video)

Treatment: 1 scoop twice daily of **Excel**.

Total score: 10 to 19:

Moderate Symptoms (similar to the horse, Casey, in the video)

- Treatment: One full tube of **Ulcer Rx** on day 1 then 1/2 tube twice daily for 10 days.
- Begin 2 scoops twice daily of **Excel** on day 5 of **Ulcer Rx** treatment.
- Order 11 tubes of **Ulcer Rx** and one 4lb. bucket of **Excel**.

Total score: 20 or higher

Severe Symptoms (similar to :the horse, Bucky, in the video)

- Treatment: One full tube of **Ulcer Rx** on day 1, then 1/2 tube twice daily for 15 days.
- Begin 2 scoops twice daily of **Excel** on day 5 of **Ulcer Rx** treatment.
- Order 16 tubes of **Ulcer Rx** and one 4lb. bucket of **Excel**.
