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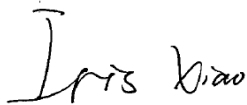

(1) On October 27, 2017, the CPSC published the final rule in the Federal Register (82 FR 49938) to restrict phthalates in toys and child care articles under section 108 of the CPSIA, this final rule has in effect restricted a total of eight phthalates in children's toys and child care articles. It will become



effective on April 25, 2018, and applies to toys and child care articles that are manufactured or imported from this date
