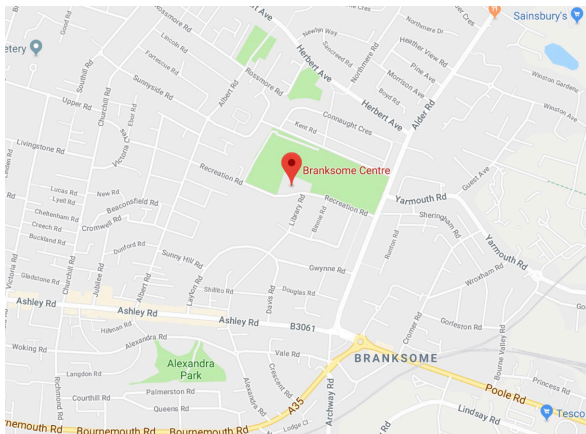

I strongly recommend you attend each session of your course as you will build on skills & knowledge gained previous sessions.

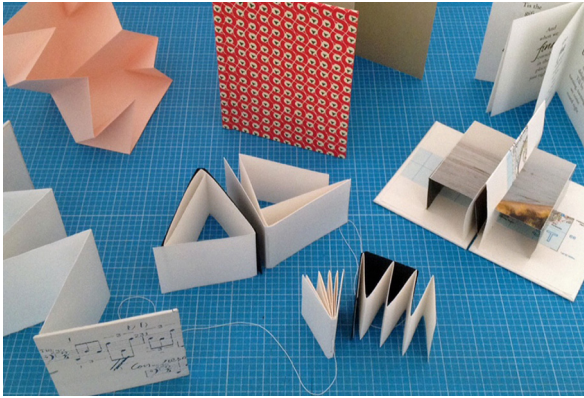

Enter a world of unusual folded book forms to inspire and express your creativity. You'll learn to make the Hot Dog, Turkish Map and Tulip folds and various Accordion - aka Concertina - styles.

Folded forms present unique opportunities for making artist's books, travelogues, pop-ups and keepsake books which we'll discuss and explore together, as much as time permits.

They are also ideal for self-publishing zines, flyers and brochures and we'll explore those possibilities together, as well.

Starting with a simple single-section paperback, you'll gain the skills and confidence to make larger books with multiple sections, plus a hardback book.

We'll be working with paper and bookcloth and will discuss how to use other materials including textiles, leather and vegan alternatives (you are welcome to bring these with you).

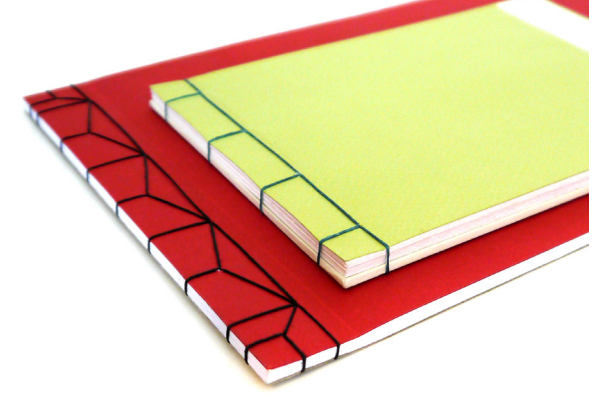

STAB STITCH BOOKS

Japanese styles for blank & printed books



Learn to make a range of attractive 'stab stitch' books in traditional Japanese styles including the Noble and Hemp Leaf bindings.

These styles are an ideal method for binding loose sheets of writing, artwork or printed pages. Alternatively bind with blank pages to make a sketchbook, scrapbook or album.

By the end of the course you'll have made at least 3 different styles and learned how to prepare the books for different end uses.
