How to care for your new plant baby.

Botanical Name

Ficus elastica, Ficus robusta

Common Name

Rubber Plant

Difficulty

Easy to Moderate



Light

Rubber Plants can live in medium, indirect sunlight to dappled sun. Prolonged exposure to bright direct sunlight may burn and scorch their leaves.



Water

Your Rubber Plant enjoys weekly waterings. Allow the soil to dry out between waterings, especially during the winter when you may only need to water your plant fortnightly.



Temperature

Your Rubber Plant will thrive in temperature between 16-24°C, but will not suffer unless temperatures drop below 10-12°C.



Toxicity

Rubber Plants are toxic to both people and animals - keep away from small children and pets.



Other Love Tips

The large leaves of the Rubber Plant easily accumulate dust over time. Wipe them clean regularly with a damp cloth. Falling leaves indicate your Rubber Plant has suffered from low humidity levels. Try misting it more frequently to remedy. Browning, drooping leaves indicates your plant has been overwatered. Ensure you let your plant's soil completely dry out between waterings, and allow proper drainage.
