InstaGone™ is an oxidizing agent that will cause bleaching on most interior cloth, fabrics, carpets, clothing, drapes and upholstery, if not covered or protected properly.

EASY Tips Before Use

- When using for interior projects, keep the room well ventilated if possible (windows or exhaust fan). For those sensitive to smells, instead of spraying, apply InstaGone™ with a brush or roller to help reduce odor.
- After using the product and removing the stain, you may wipe or rinse the treated surface with clean water to remove any residue. (Note: This does not apply to surfaces such as acoustic ceiling tiles or spray textured "popcorn" ceilings.)
- When spraying stains above your head (ceilings), do not stand directly under the area you are treating. Extend an arm in front of you and spray.
- If InstaGone™ is used on chrome or metal items, let sit for 5 -10 min, then rinse or wipe with water after applying.

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ: You must flush the trigger sprayer after you finish using it and before you store it away. To do this, remove the trigger sprayer and place the end of the dip tube into a glass of clean water. Squeeze the trigger sprayer 7-8 times, allowing the inside of the sprayer to be flushed out with clean water. Then place the trigger sprayer (with filter) back into the bottle. This will ensure proper use for next time. (NOTE: Perform this method when you have used InstaGone™ with any type of trigger sprayer, pump sprayer or pressure sprayer). For the 48 oz. and 1-gallon pump sprayer, rinse with water and fill 1/4 of the way with clean water. Pump handle several times and squeeze the trigger, allowing the clean water to spray out thoroughly. For the garden hose attachment, just run water through.

FAQ

Q: If InstaGone™ is on any vegetation, what should I do?

A: Not a problem! Simply rinse with water to dilute InstaGone™.

Q: How long will InstaGone™ last after mixing with water?

A: InstaGone™ will remain strong for approximately 6-8 months.

Q: Where can I store my unused InstaGone™ packets?

A: Unused packets of InstaGone™ should be kept in a dry, cool area to ensure longer shelf life (1-1.5 years).

Q: What should I do if my sprayer is clogged?

A: Excessive shaking before sediment is settled may cause particles to move into the "dip tube" and spray nozzle to create clogging. Remember, once you initially mix InstaGone™ by shaking, you do not need to shake again for the duration of the bottle. If you shake the bottle by accident, just let sediment settle for 5 minutes before using again. If your sprayer still seems clogged, remove sprayer and place dip tube in a half of glass of warm water. Squeeze trigger 7-8 times until sprayer is unclogged. It is good practice to flush the sprayer after daily use. If this still does not unclog sprayer, in emergencies you can temporarily use another trigger sprayer (remember to save filter on original dip tube sprayer and attach it to new dip tube after cutting). Make sure the dip tube is 1" from the bottom of the bottle. If needed, use scissors to cut the end. This will stop the sprayer from siphoning the inert material or residual sediment from the bottom of the bottle. You can also call our Customer Service Department for further assistance.

PRODUCT DIRECTIONS:

24 oz. TRIGGER SPRAYER BOTTLE

For filling a 24-oz. bottle (709 mL.): Fill with room-temperature water leaving 2 inches of space from the top. Add the contents of (1) pre-measured .8-oz. (23g) packet to water. Screw sprayer onto the bottle and shake for 20-30 seconds for proper mixing. After mixing, let it settle for 5-10 minutes before use to ensure that it is fully activated.

48 oz. CAPACITY PRESSURE SPRAYER

For filling InstaGone's™ 48-oz. capacity Pressure Sprayer (1420 mL.): Fill with water to fill-line and add (2) pre-measured .8-oz. (23g) packets. Screw pump sprayer onto bottle and shake for 20-30 seconds for proper mixing. Make sure all parts, including spray tip, are fully tightened and correctly adjusted before shaking and spraying. Let settle for 5-10 minutes to ensure it is fully

activated. Lastly, pump sprayer to pressurize before applying to surface.

1-GALLON PUMP SPRAYER

If using a 1-gallon chemical-resistant pump sprayer (128 oz; 3785 mL.) for larger areas (patio furniture, small fencing, etc.): The ratio is 3-4, .8 oz. packets per 1 gallon of water, depending on severity of stains. For set-in or older stains, add 1 more packet per gallon of water. To properly mix, follow these easy directions: Use a clean, empty one gallon plastic screw top container for initial mixing. Add water to container, leaving enough room to add 4 or 5, pre-measured .8 oz. packets. Screw cap on and shake for 30 seconds. Let settle to activate for 5-10 more minutes. Before pouring into the 1-gallon pump sprayer, unscrew cap and use a cheese cloth or siphoning-type screen to stretch over the pouring spout. Securing the cloth or screen with a rubber band will work. We recommend this process to ensure no clogging. Some garden sprayers may not have a filter at the bottom of the dip tube, which is why we recommend premixing in a separate plastic container first, while siphoning or holding back the inert or undissolved material from your pump sprayer.

GARDEN HOSE ATTACHMENT

For your garden hose attachment - fill the 24 oz. (709 mL.) bottle 2" from the top with water, and add 1 pre-measured .8 oz packets (for severe stains you can add an extra packet). Securely fasten the garden hose attachment, shake for 15 seconds and let activate for 5-10 minutes. Read directions on back of 24 oz. bottle for additional garden hose attachment instructions.

TIP: Need more than one bottle's worth? Try mixing 4-5 packets with a gallon of water in a separate plastic container. This saves you time by eliminating the mixing/activating steps.

On the following adapters, 24oz, 48 oz, and 1 gallon (not the garden hose attachment), adjust the spray nozzle to desired setting. To test the setting, spray into the sink or an outside area. Avoid any over spray, as it may cause staining and/or bleaching on fabric material (including clothing).

HOW TO CLEAN SPECIFIC SURFACES & STAINS:

Note: Surface should be dry and free of debris when applying InstaGone™ to any stained area.

Spray Textured (Popcorn & California Style) Ceilings, including Stucco, Orange Peel & Knockdown Effect Ceilings, Walls and Acoustical Ceiling Tile

To remove water stains, mold, mildew, soot, nicotine, etc., always cover the floor, drapes, and furniture first in order to prevent unwanted staining or bleaching. Apply product by spraying, brushing or rolling. To avoid dripping, do not saturate the area. Do not stand directly under the area you are treating with InstaGone™. Wait five minutes before inspecting the treated area. To avoid damaging a textured surface, DO NOT wipe or rub the stained area—just spray. If possible, when treating acoustical ceiling tiles, we suggest removing the stained ceiling tile and bringing it outside to treat and let dry in the sunlight for quicker activation. For all surfaces, spray directly on stained area. (Note: Wait 5-10 minutes for results. Re-apply if necessary. DO NOT wipe or rub the stained area.)

Painted Ceilings and Walls

To remove water stains, mold, mildew, soot, nicotine, etc., always test InstaGone™ in a small inconspicuous area to ensure colorfastness. If there is no change in color, apply product by spraying, brushing or rolling. Always cover floors, rugs, drapes, and furniture first to prevent unwanted bleaching. Wait 10-15 minutes, then wipe the treated area with a damp sponge or cloth.

Vinyl Materials: Outdoor Seat Cushions, Patio Umbrellas, Pool Liners & In-ground Pool Coping

To remove hard water stains, mold, mildew, soot, bird droppings, wine, leaf stains, etc., always test InstaGone™ in a small, inconspicuous area to ensure colorfastness. If there is no change in color, apply product by spraying, brushing or rolling. For best results, use in direct sunlight. Wait 10-15 minutes, then wipe the treated area with a damp sponge, cloth, or rinse with garden hose. Some heavily soiled areas may require several applications. Remember to totally dry area before applying more applications.

Section 5

PVC, Fiberglass & Resin Furniture, and PVC Fencing

For hard water stains, mold, mildew, soot, bird droppings, wine, leaf stains etc., apply InstaGone™ by spraying or brushing. Before applying InstaGone™, it is important to rinse all areas down with a garden hose to remove loose dirt and debris. After hosing, let dry for 24 hours. This will allow InstaGone™ to penetrate the surface quicker and easier. Once dry, apply InstaGone™ by spraying or brushing. Do not wipe off. For best results, use in direct sunlight. After 10-15 minutes, rinse furniture with a garden hose. (For larger areas consider using InstaGone's™ Garden Hose Attachment or InstaGone's™ 48 oz Pump Sprayer).

Grout, Tiles and Caulking

To remove hard water stains, mold, mildew, soot, etc., for best results, apply InstaGone™ by spraying or using a sponge. Wait 5-10 minutes before examining stained area. Repeat if necessary. For best results, apply InstaGone™ on grout line with a scrubber-type sponge or brush. This will loosen any soap scum or calcium buildup. Note: Several applications may be needed on bathroom grout and caulk due to the soap scum build-up. After stain is removed, wipe with a damp sponge, cloth or rinse with water.

Aluminum, Vinyl or Wood Exterior Siding and Shutters, Masonry, Stucco, Stone, Concrete, Brick Sidewalks, Patio Block, etc.

To remove, mold, mildew, soot, bird droppings, leaf stains, etc.- Apply InstaGone™ by spraying, brushing or rolling. Do not wipe off. For best results, use in direct sunlight. Wait 5-10 minutes before examining area. Some stains may require more than one application (waiting 10 minutes between each application). When stain is removed, rinse treated area with a garden hose. For larger areas, it is recommended to use a garden pump sprayer or InstaGone's™ Garden Hose Attachment for application. This will allow you to cover the larger areas quicker. For best results, hose the areas first and let dry 24 hours before applying InstaGone™. When using on concrete or plastic bird baths, rinse thoroughly once stain has been removed.

Section 6

Recreational Vehicles, including but not limited to: Motorhomes, Pop-up Campers, Tow-Behinds, Awnings, Boats, Jet Skis, Golf Carts & ATVs.

It is best to clean off loose dirt and debris and let surface dry thoroughly before spraying with InstaGone™. Use on rubber and fiberglass roofs, water hook-up areas, Olefin carpeted-type ceilings for water stains, bathrooms and showers, PVC fittings, vinyl awnings, canvas, tents, Tyvek® for pop-ups and camper covers, etc. (always test for color fastness).

Pressure-Treated Lumber & Wood Composite Surfaces, including Decks, Railroad Ties, Docks, Bulkheads, etc.

To remove mold, mildew, soot, algae, bird droppings, leaf stains, food and beverage stains, etc. on these surfaces apply InstaGone™ by spraying, brushing, or rolling. Do not wipe off. For best results, use in direct sunlight. Wait 5-10 minutes before examining area. When stain is removed, rinse treated area with clean water from garden hose. For best results, rinse the area first and let dry 24 hours before applying InstaGone™. (For larger areas consider using InstaGone's™ Garden Hose Attachment or 1 gallon pump sprayer).

Washing Machines, Dish Washers, Refrigerators and Freezers

To remove hard water stains, mold, mildew, and food stains, etc.- For refrigerators, freezers & rubber sealants, apply InstaGone™ with a white cloth. Wipe with cloth to remove the mold and mildew spots. Wait 5-10 minutes before examining area. Rinse treated area thoroughly with soap and water using a new washcloth. For washing machines & dishwashers: Once a month, add half of a packet of InstaGone™ to your empty washing machine or dishwasher and run one normal cycle with InstaGone™ and then run an additional rinse or wash cycle with just water. This will prevent iron, rust & hard water stains and mold & mildew odors. This is useful for both top loaders and front loader washing machines. Note: on front loader washing machines, cleaning the rubber seal with InstaGone™ will prevent mold and mildew odors.

Section 7

CAUTION: Use only as directed. Mix only with water. Do not mix with ammonia, acids or other compounds. Do not ingest. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water and contact a physician, or call The American Association of Poison Control immediately at 1-800-222-1222. Find your local Poison Control Center on the web at www.aapcc.org. Avoid contact with eyes or skin. If product comes in contact with eyes or skin, flush thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. As an extra safety precaution for people sensitive to odors, wear goggles or gloves when handling or applying this product in non-ventilated or small closed areas. If you have serious respiratory conditions, COPD issues, etc., please use with caution or avoid using in closed areas. A chemical respiratory mask is suggested if you have any of these issues. Dispose of unused product by flushing down drain or toilet and follow with water or pursue applicable local state or federal regulations. WARNING: For best results, read product directions and label thoroughly. InstaGone™ is a halogen releasing, oxidizing agent that will cause bleaching on most interior cloth, fabrics, carpets, clothing, drapes and upholstery, if not covered or protected properly. Before using on painted surfaces, test for colorfastness by applying InstaGone™ to a small, inconspicuous area and wait until thoroughly dry (some paint pigments may experience bleaching). If these steps are not taken, the manufacturer, distributor, and retailer will not assume any responsibility for damages caused by this product. Therefore, make sure that all nearby objects not being treated with InstaGone™ are covered with plastic or a waterproof tarp. Always use product in a well-ventilated area when applying indoors, especially small areas. **PLEASE NOTE:** 1. When spraying in a non-ventilated area with no exhaust or window, you should apply with brush, rag or sponge to keep odor at low levels (some people may be more sensitive to odors than others). 2. If the odor is too strong, please remove yourself from the area and let the room air out before re-entering to finish. It may take 15 minutes or more to do this. 3. InstaGone™ is in a concentrated form. When using the spray bottle, the odor will intensify with each spray. Very little is needed.
