## User Manual

Thank you for buying our August product. You may already be familiar with using a similar product but please take time to read these instructions carefully. It is designed to familiarise you with the features of the product and to ensure that you get the very best from your purchase.

### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Main features

- 1) Pedometer: Step Counter, Distance Display and Calorie Counter
- 2) Time Display: 12-Hour Format, Hour and Minute

#### 1.2 Care and storage

- 1) Keep the item out of reach of children.
- 2) Clean the device with a soft dry cloth. Do not use any abrasive or volatile cleaners.
- 3) The item is not waterproof. Do not wash it or do not touch it with wet hands. Be careful water does not get into the unit.

- 4) Avoid exposure of the item to direct sunlight, high temperatures, high humidity, water and/or dust.
- 5) Do not drop or step on the device.
- 6) The operating environment of the device must be free from excessive vibrations, shocks, magnetic fields, electrical noise, etc.
- 7) Remove the battery if the item will not be used for three months or longer. Do not throw the battery into fire, it may explode.
- 8) Do not disassemble the device, as this will invalidate the warranty.

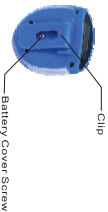
### 2. Overview

## 3. Settings

### 3.1 First time using the device

#### Set to metric or Imperial format

When first time using the device, take out the battery insulator from the back of the device.

The display will show  , if you prefer using the

Metric format, press SET to confirm, otherwise press MODE to change to Imperial and the screen will show  in  lb , press SET to confirm.

**Note:** If you need to switch to a different format after the format has already been set, please take out the pedometer battery up to one minute and then put it back in again, the device will then go back to the initial status, then follow the instruction above to set the format.

### 3.2 Time setting

The device will go to Time and show "12:00A", once the Metric or Imperial format has been set, press and hold SET for 3 seconds, the hour flashes on the screen, press MODE to change the hour, press SET to confirm, the minute flashes, press MODE to change the minute, press SET to confirm.


### 3.3 Step counter

When the device shows time, press MODE,  will appear, which means Step Counter is at zero, if the display is not zero, press SET to return to zero.

### 3.4 Stride length setting

**Setting range:** 10-80 inch (30-200 cm),  
**default:** 24 inch (60 cm).

When the device is in Step Counter, press **MODE**,

 Will appear, press and hold **SET** for 3 seconds,


the stride length flashes on the screen, press **MODE** to change it by increment of 5 cm, press **SET** to confirm the stride.

When the stride reaches 200 cm, it will start from 5 cm after pressing **MODE**.

### 3.5 Weight setting

**Setting range:** 70-250 lb (30-120 kg),  
**default:** 130 lb (60 kg).

When the device is in Distance Display, press **MODE**,

 will appear, press and hold **SET** for 3 seconds, the

weight flashes on the screen, press **MODE** to change it by increment of 2 kg, press **SET** to confirm the weight.

When the weight reaches 120 kg, it will start from 30 kg after pressing **MODE**.

## 4. Attaching the step counter

### 4.1 How to attach the step counter

Attach the device to your belt or the top of your waistband. Try to position the device so that the display is upright.

#### Note:

- Do not place the device in the back pocket of your pants.
- The clip may cause scratches to the belt if it is attached or removed roughly, depending on the belt quality.

## 5. Using the step counter

- 1) Attach the device to your body, please refer to 4.1
- 2) Start walking
- 3) Press **MODE** to display the data.
- 4) The default mode of the device is Time, when there is no operation for 2 mins, the device will go to the default mode.

The unit may not count steps correctly under the following conditions:

- 1) Incorrect unit position
- 2) Make sure the unit is placed at vertical position.
- 3) Walking at an inconsistent pace
- 3) Irregular movement

## 6. Battery installation

### 6.1 How to replace the battery

An AG3 1.5V battery is installed in the device when this unit is purchased.

If the display turns faint, please replace the battery with a new one immediately. When the battery is removed from the unit all the setting will be erased, please refer to 3. to reset the device.

- 1) Remove the clip as shown below



- 2) Use a small screwdriver to remove the screw on the battery cover, then remove the battery cover.



- 3) Remove the old battery

Caution:

- Dispose of the device, batteries and components according to applicable local regulations.
- Do not throw the batteries into fire. The battery may explode.

- 4) Place the new battery in the direction shown on the device.

- 5) Replace the battery cover, tighten the screw on the battery cover.

- 6) Slide and push the clip back into the slot.

## 7. Trouble shooting

Phenomenon	Cause	Solution
No or faint display	Battery low or exhausted.	Replace with a new battery immediately.
Displayed values are incorrect.	The unit is attached incorrectly.	Refer to 4. 1
	You are walking at inconsistent pace.	Walk at consistent pace all the time.
	Settings are wrong.	Change settings.
