

USER INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARASOLS

SAFETY

- Close the parasol in the event of upcoming winds, sudden wind and wind gusts. Do not allow the parasol to flap in the wind, as this can cause damage to the fabric. Unattended parasols may not be left open. Any damage thus caused is not covered by the guarantee.
- If you operate the parasol, ensure that persons or objects are sufficiently far away to prevent them coming into contact with the parasol, otherwise this can result in injury or material damage.
- The anchoring must be appropriate for the size of the parasol.
- Parasols must only be used as protection against the sun.

OPERATION

- Remove the band and gently pull the fabric between the ribs to release it.
- Slide the handgrip upwards and open the parasol using the handle.
 Turn the handle in the indicated direction, but do not force the handle. If the parasol does not open easily, you must gently pull the ribs loose.
- At first always place the cover in the horizontal position before you move the handle higher or lower.
- Ensure that the parasol is fully open and taut during use.
- After closing the parasol, pull out all fabric sections separately and completely between the ribs. Roll up the fabric sections on top of each other and use the band to secure them to the pole.

MAINTENANCE

- Check screws and bolts monthly and tighten them if needed.
- Allow a wet parasol to dry in fully opened position. If a wet parasol has to be closed, open it again as soon as possible and allow it to dry.
- If you do not use the parasol, always use a protective cover to prevent unnecessary wear caused by the weather. Only place a protective cover over a dry parasol.
- Store the parasol in a dry place when not in use for a longer period.
- If necessary, clean the parasol using lukewarm water, soft detergent and a soft sponge. If you wish to, the parasol can be impregnated with spray. Use a soft brush to remove any dust.
- Use a damp cloth to wipe away any glide marks on the aluminium profiles.
- Store these instructions for future reference.

USER INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARASOL BASES

SAFETY:

- This product is heavy. The parasol base must always be moved by a minimum of 2 adults.
- The handles that are attached to the bases, are intended for carefully moving the base; these handles may not, under any circumstances, be used to lift the bases.

OPERATION

- Always move a parasol base with swivel wheels slowly across your terrace. If your terrace is
 uneven, we advise you to lift the parasol base over any irregularities instead of just pulling
 the parasol base over them.
 - If you bump against these irregularities, the wheels underneath the parasol base can break off.
- Always apply all brakes on a parasol with swivel wheels in order to prevent it from rolling away.
- The anchoring must be appropriate for the size of the parasol.
- Parasol bases must only be operated by adults.

MAINTENANCE

- A stainless steel cleaner can be used to easily remove flash rust on stainless steel tubes.
- Granite can become discoloured after some time. You can restore the colour by using a
 granite colour intensifier. A colour intensifier impregnates, nourishes and protects the
 granite.
- We advise you to cover the parasol base or place it indoors during the autumn and winter.
- Store these instructions for future reference.
