Where you install your product depends on its material/s.


Wooden and Steel Products: We recommend using these products inside or under a shelter where they are protected from any exposure to rain or water.

Aluminum Products: These products are non-corrosive and suitable for use outside.

Chalk Products: You should use traditional dry chalk. We don't recommend using liquid chalk pens on our products.


Transportable Outdoor Signage: If there is exposure to wind, we recommend bringing signage inside to protect it from the extremes. We offer Sandbags to help support your product in moderate wind conditions.

Begin assembling your A-Frame Sign by getting the two legs and placing them opposite each other so that the keyed legs face each other.




Thread the main bolt ① through the end cap ②, legs and horizontal brace ③. Do this on both sides and tighten firmly. The legs should open and close now. Make sure when they are open the bottom of the legs sit flat on the ground.

Note: Firmly tighten to ensure the legs stay open.




Apply your decals or vinyls to the display board. For a custom look you can even paint the display board.




Place one leather strap over the horizontal brace and use the display board bolt (1) and nut (2) to fix the display board in place. Make sure there is a washer (3) on each side of the leather strap. Do this on both sides of the display board. The leather straps will sit in the groves of the horizontal brace.



If your sign has to endure windy conditions, we have included a stabilizing bar to help it from being blown over. This goes between the legs and screws in from the underside. The sign can be used with or without this feature.



In the case of extreme conditions, a sandbag can be filled and saddled over the stabilizing bar for additional support. 7



The A-Frame Sign is now ready to be used. To store or move the sign with ease, simply push the legs together.
