

Assembly


Attaching the connecting bar

- Attach the connecting bar (C) to table legs (B) using M6x15mm bolts(AA) and M6 washers(CC).
- □ Tighten all M6x15 bolts (AA) with the M6-M8 wrench (EE).
- □ Cover the bolt heads with M6 bolt caps (DD).



2 Attaching the table legs

- □ Attach the table legs(B) to table top(A) using M6x20mm bolts (BB) and M6washers (CC).
- □ Tighten all M6x20 bolts (BB) with the M6-M8 wrench (EE).
- □ Cover the bolt heads with M6 bolt caps (DD).



3 Positioning the table

- $\hfill\Box$ Turn the table over and set it down on its legs.
- □ The table is now ready for use.



Care and Cleaning

- □ Do not allow water to build up in the frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. Do not use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.
- □ Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- □ Treat the frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.
