
Assembly

Attaching the arms to the back panel

Attach the right arm (A) and left arm (B) to the back panel (D) with the M6 x 35 bolts (AA).




NOTE: Please ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly. Do not tighten bolts until the frame assembly is complete.




2 Attaching the seat panel

- □ Attach the seat panel (C) to the arms (A and B) with the M6 x 35 bolts (AA).
- □ Tighten all the bolts with the Allen wrench (GG).




3 Attaching the T-rock

- □ Attach the T-rock (F) to the finished frame with four M8 x 50mm hex bolts in the order of bolts (CC), M8 washers (DD), rectangular steel plates (I), chair seat (C), T-rock (F), rectangular steel plates (I), M8 washers (DD), M8 spring washers (EE) and M8 nuts (BB).
- ☐ Tighten all M8 x 50mm bolts (CC) with M6-M8 hex wrench (FF).



4 Connecting the chair base to the chair bucket


□ Turn the chair right side up. Insert the chair bucket into the chair base (E).



Assembly (continued)

5 Adding the cushions

 $\hfill\Box$ Place the seat cushion (G) and back cushion (H) on the lounge chair. The chair is now ready for use.



Care and Cleaning






Assembly

Attaching the table legs

- □ Place the table top (A) on a soft, flat non-abrasive surface.
- Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) with the M6 x 20 bolts (AA).




NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the Allen wrench (BB).




2 Attaching the shelf to the table legs

- $\hfill\Box$ Attach the shelf (C) to the four table legs (B) by using the M6 x 20 bolts (AA).
- □ Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten all the bolts.



3 Positioning the table

□ Turn the table over and now the table is ready for use.



Care and Cleaning
