




Assembly

1 Attaching the left arm to the seat panel

 $\hfill\Box$ Attach the left arm (D) to the seat panel (A) with M6 x 35mm bolts (BB) and M6 x 25mm bolts (CC).




NOTE: Please ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly. Do not tighten bolts until the frame assembly is complete.



2 Attaching the right arm to the seat panel


□ Attach the right arm (C) to the seat panel (A) with M6 x 35mm bolts (BB) and M6 x 25mm bolts (CC).



Assembly (continued)


Adding the back panel to the seat panel

- □ Attach the back panel (B) to the seat panel (A) with M6 x 30mm bolts (AA) and plastic washers (EE).
- □ Tighten all the bolts with the M6 Allen wrench (DD).



4 Adding the cushions

Put the seat cushion (F) and back cushion (E) on the chaise.
 The chaise is now ready for use.



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Care and Cleaning

- Do not allow water to build up in the frames. This will cause corrosion and possible freezing damage in cold climates.
- Use a mild soap and water for normal cleaning. Do not use janitorial or alcohol based cleaners. Some cleaners may be marked as natural, but some ingredients may cause discoloration or have an adverse reaction to your finish.
- □ Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft, absorbent cloth towel.
- □ Treat the frames with a liquid wax for maximum protection against UV rays and/or salty, damp air.
