## RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER

**WARNING:** Like any other moving product, using the KaZAM Balance Bike can be a dangerous activity and may result in injury or death even when used with proper safety precautions. Use at your own risk and use common sense.

#### **WARNINGS:**

- When unpacking the KaZAM mini, properly dispose of all plastic wrappings.
- Adult supervision is strongly recommended at all times.
- The KaZAM mini should only be used by children ages 12+ months.
- The KaZAM mini is for indoor/outdoor use.
- Never use the KaZAM mini near steps, swimming pools, other bodies of water or vehicle traffic.
- Never use the KaZAM mini on sloped driveways and hills or rough or uneven surfaces. For use on smooth paved surfaces only.
- · The KaZAM mini has no brake system. The rider should stop the bicycle with his or her feet.
- Never use the KaZAM mini in wet or icy conditions, at night or at times of limited visibility.
- Always wear proper protective gear such as an approved helmet and elbow and kneepads. Failure to wear an
  approved helmet may result in serious injury or death.
- Always wear closed-toe shoes when riding the KaZAM mini.
- Never allow more than one child to ride the KaZAM mini at any time.
- The maximum load should not exceed 40 lbs. or 18 kg.



#### **ALWAYS WEAR A HELMET - IT COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE!**

A properly fitting, CPSC approved, bicycle helmet should be worn at all times when riding. The correct helmet should:

- be comfortable
- be lightweight
- have good ventilation
- fit correctly
- cover the forehead
- be securely fastened on the rider.

# **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**



- **Step 1:** Insert the front wheel set (2) through the frame's (1) steering tube as described in the illustration.
- **Step 2:** Using the wrench (4) provided, remove screw and nut from the handlebar (3) and insert handlebar (3) into front wheel set (2) post as described in the illustration.
- **Step 3:** Aligning the post openings of the assembled handlebar and front wheel set, insert the screw through the post openings securely attaching the nut as described in the illustration. Lock in place the black protective covering to the upper black cup affixed to steering tube.

# **KaZAM MINI CARE**

- Wipe with a damp cloth using soap water only to remove dirt and dust. Dry thoroughly before use. This will prolong the useful life
  of the product. Using industrial cleaners or solvents may damage surface areas. Using alcohol or ammonia-based cleaners may
  also damage plastic components.
- Routinely check that all parts are securely fastened and are in good working condition before each use.
