Owner's Manual

The KaZAM balance bike provides an alternative way to learn to ride a pedaled bike based on the concept of balance first, pedal last. It is a balance bike that assists children ages 3 years and up to learn balance, increase coordination and ultimately ride a traditional bicycle for the first time with confidence. This customized toddler balance bike has the steering and balancing challenges of a traditional bike but it has no pedals, chain or training wheels. It is uniquely designed with a foot rest area for balancing, thereby making the transition onto a pedaled bike quicker and seamless!

The KaZAM balance bike is small enough for a child to sit comfortably on the seat with feet flat on the ground. Children learn to walk, scoot, run, balance and eventually ride the KaZAM balance bike while in the sitting position. They gain confidence, lifting both feet off the ground onto the foot rest, and cruise while balancing on two wheels. Children will naturally learn to balance on their own, at their own pace.

OVERVIEW



This symbol is important. It is the WARNING symbol. The warning symbol precedes safety instructions. This manual contains important safety information. WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD – Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.



WARNING: Like any other moving product using the KaZAM Balance Bike can be a dangerous activity and may result in injury or death even when used with proper safety precautions. Use at your own risk and use common sense.



WARNINGS:

- · Adult supervision is strongly recommended at all times. This applies to assembly and operation of the KaZAM Balance Bike.
- · When unpacking the KaZAM Balance Bike, properly dispose of all plastic wrappings.
- The KaZAM Balance Bike should only be used by children ages 3 years and up.
- · Never use the KaZAM Balance Bike near steps, swimming pools, other bodies of water or vehicle traffic.
- · Never use the KaZAM Balance Bike on sloped driveways and hills or rough or uneven surfaces.
- · For use on smooth paved surfaces only.
- The KaZAM Balance Bike has no brake system. The rider should stop the KaZAM Balance Bike with his or her feet.
- · Never use the KaZAM Balance Bike in wet or icy conditions, at night or at times of limited visibility.
- To prevent falls, the seat should be adjusted accordingly to allow the feet to rest on the ground.
- · Always wear a CPSC, CEN or other approved helmet when riding your KaZAM Balance Bike. Always keep the chin strap securely buckled. Failure to wear an approved helmet may result in serious injury or death.
- · Always wear closed-toe shoes when riding the KaZAM Balance Bike.
- The KaZAM Balance Bike should not be used on public roads. It is strongly recommended the KaZAM Balance Bike be used only in areas such as playgrounds or appropriate safe locations.
- · The maximum load should not exceed 60 lbs. or 27 kg.
- · Please observe the minimum/maximum insertion depth marks for seat post and handlebar stem.
- · For rubber tires: maintain proper tire pressure (35 psi). Under inflated tires increase the likelihood of blowouts. Check air pressure with a gauge. If a tire gauge is not available, pinch tire between the thumb and forefinger; the tire should feel firm. The correct tire pressure is marked on the side of the tire. DO NOT OVER INFLATE. Follow these safety guidelines: The KaZAM Balance Bike meets United States and European toy safety standards.


WARNINGS

Slide wheel axle onto forks Tighten nuts on each side









Place the KaZAM Balance Bike on a smooth, flat surface at all times.



Sit with feet on the ground, lean slightly forward, and grip handle bars with hands.



The correct seat and handlebar adjustments are important factors in getting the most performance and comfort from your bicycle.

Adjust the seat height so that the feet reach the ground when riding. The handlebar height should be adjusted accordingly so that the rider can comfortably reach the handlebars in the seated position.




To propel the KaZAM Balance Bike forward, push by alternating with both feet continuously.



Place feet on the footrest and practice balancing while gliding.



To bring the KaZAM Balance Bike to a stop, wait for the bicycle to slow and put your feet on the ground.



Wipe with a damp cloth to remove dirt and dust. This will prolong the useful life of the product.



Using industrial cleaners or solvents may damage surface areas.



Using alcohol or ammonia- based cleaners may damage plastic components.
