TAKE THE TRAIN TO SINTRA in Portugal and stay at the Hotel Tivoli Palácio de Seteais Sintra (tivolihotels.com). You'll find yourself on a mountain atop the world in a forest filled with castles. It's like a fairy tale, packed with the kind of history that makes your imagination soar.
