



ICE DYEING

You will need: White prewashed T-shirt, Procion MX Dyes, Soda Ash, Dust Mask, Calgon PT (if in a hard water area), Rubber Gloves, Apron, Ice, Cooling rack, Plastic Bowl, Bubble Wrap.



Step 1) Mix three tablespoons of Soda Ash with warm water. If you are working in a hard water area add one tablespoon of Calgon.



Step 2) Soak your T-shirt in the Soda Ash solution for 15 minutes



Step 3) Place a cooling rack over a plastic bowl - so the fabric does not sit in the excess dye. Squeeze out as much of the Soda Ash as you can. Scrunch your T-shirt into a rectangular shape.



Step 4) Cover the T-shirt with Ice



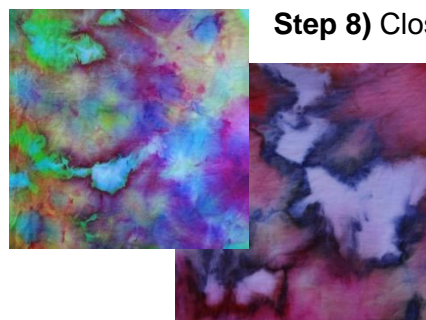
Step 5) Wearing a dust mask sprinkle dry Procion MX dye onto the ice in a random pattern. We used Indigo, Scarlet and Olive for one T-shirt on the left and Lemon Yellow, Magenta and Turquoise for the other.



Step 6) Cover with bubble wrap and leave for 24 hours. Remove and rinse with cold water until water runs clear. Wash on a 40°C cycle to remove excess dye using a non bio washing powder or Colspere.



Step 7) The finished item
