Studio Usage - £5 per hour per person

Group bookings are welcome, charged at £5 per hour per person. Exclusive use of the studio is granted to groups of 6 or more. If less than 6 and exclusive use is required, there is a minimum charge of £30 per hour.

One-to-One Tuition/Help - £30 per hour

Chargeable in increments of 10 mins: £5 for 10mins, £10 for 20mins, £15 for 30mins etc.

Induction - £10 (1 Hour)

Our induction is a requirement for first time users of our studio, or for those who haven't been in the last year and need a refresher. Our staff will give you a detailed tour of the studio, cover aspects of health and safety and show you how to use our equipment so you can work confidently and efficiently. For some equipment, there may be an additional tuition charge required. Please let us know if you have any specific requirements or equipment requests.

Studio Consumables

You're welcome to bring your own supplies to use in our studio, providing they adhere to our health and safety standards. Please do not use any acids, white spirits, or strong-smelling substances in the studio.

You can purchase any items from the shop downstairs, or purchase any of our studio consumables. Please make a note of any studio consumables you use, so that we can help you accordingly on check out.

We have studio screens of various sizes and mesh counts that you are welcome to use. Please see the detailed price list for costs of films, exposing, and cleaning. Please do not use your own emulsion on our screens.

If you are finished with your screen, please clean it, and remove all emulsion at the end of your session.

If you to want to use your exposed screen on your next visit, we will store your screen for you. The first week of storage is free, with a rental fee of £2 per week beyond this, to be paid for in advance. Your screen may be reclaimed if your rental expires.

Printing Ink and Sundries

Screen Printing Ink - £3 for fabric ink (made with pigments) / £4 for paper ink (made with acrylics)

We will provide a pre-measured pot of ink binder for your chosen method, and you can use pigments (for fabric) or acrylics (for paper) to mix the shade you require. You can also purchase various shades of 'seconds' ink for £2 per pot.

Relief / Intaglio Printing Ink – a small charge depending on use.

Storage

Work can be left to dry on our drying racks, to be collected within a week. Any work left on the drying rack and not collected will be placed in the communal drawer. This drawer will be emptied bi-annually and any work left here for too long could be at risk of being destroyed.

Mixed inks can be stored on the designated shelf. Please write your name and the date on your pot. We will periodically check this area and dispose of any ink that has dried up. Ink older than 6 months will be donated across to the 'free for use' shelf.

Refreshments

Water, tea, coffee, and squash is available to make in our kitchen, free of charge. Please help yourself and remember to clean up any crockery or utensils you may use.

Cleaning

When you've finished your session, please ensure you clean up any areas you've worked in, and clean any tools you've used. Newspaper, rags, dish soap, sponges and buckets are available for you to use – please use what is appropriate or seek advice if you are unsure. Please do not leave anything in the sink to soak.
