


PRINTED WRAPPING PAPER USING SCREEN FILLER



Step 1) Draw the image on a piece of paper.



Step 5) Tape up the edges of the screen with parcel tape.



Step 2) Using a disappearing pen or pencil trace the image onto the screen.



Step 6) Using a water based screen printing ink flood the screen and then print the image onto brown kraft paper. Repeat as necessary being careful not to place the screen onto wet ink.



Step 3) Raise the edges of the screen away from the table by placing a wedge, such as a coin under each corner. Using a fine brush paint the screen filler around the outlines.



Step 7) Leave the paper to dry fully. The image can be removed from the screen with Speedclean.



Step 4) Fill in the rest of the image with screen filler. Leave to dry fully. When dry hold the screen up to a light any areas that you can see through will print. Paint extra screen filler onto the mesh where needed.



Step 8) The finished parcel ready to be torn open!
