

Highlights of 2013's PASOLINI - A Film Series

BERTOLUCCI - A Film Series follows the success of the 2013 film series PASOLINI, which presented six works from the legendary Pier Paolo Pasolini. This was the first special project organized by Amelia Antonucci in collaboration with Italy's national film institution Luce-Cinecittà in Rome and the Italian Cultural Institute of San Francisco. It was presented in association with the Ministry of Culture of Italy and the Consulate General of Italy in San Francisco. It took place on September 14th, 2013, at the world-famous Castro Theatre and on September 15th, at the historic Roxie Theatre in the Mission district. Over 1,500 people attended the two-day film festival, which welcomed to San Francisco the celebrated Italian actor Ninetto Davoli, and showcased the new restoration of the classic film MEDEA starring Maria Callas. PASOLINI was a special cinematic highlight in the Bay Area cultural calendar of Fall 2013, and was publicized in the major news agencies of the region, including the San Francisco Chronicle (Arts & Entertainment cover story), the Bay Guardian, SF Weekly, the Bay Area Reporter, etc. Below are some photo souvenirs.
