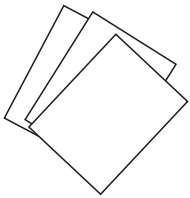


Red-Nosed Reindeer!

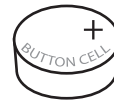

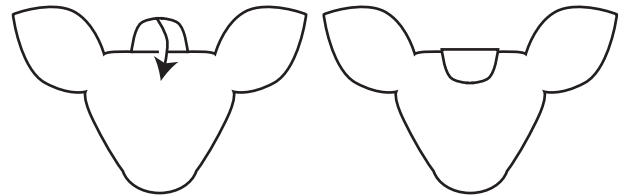

1 CUT OUT PAPER SHAPES

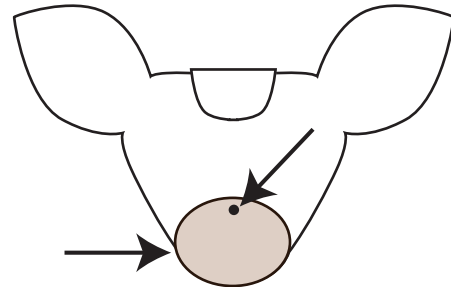
Use template page to help with shapes for reindeer face.

2 FOLD TAB at TOP OF FACE



3 STICK ON MUZZLE

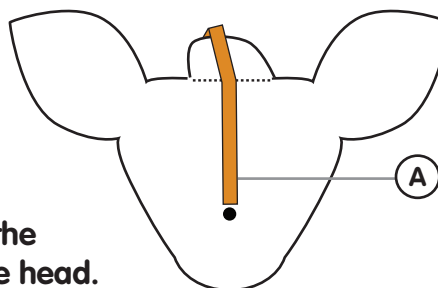
Use glue or tape to stick muzzle onto the bottom of your reindeer face. Use paper clip point or scissors to poke a hole through both layers of paper. This will be used for the nose.



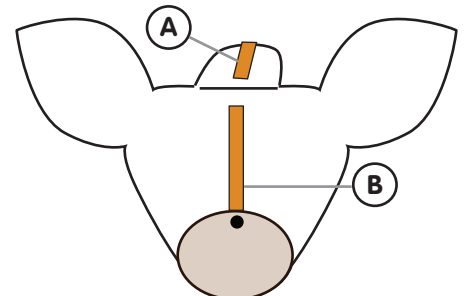
4 APPLY CONDUCTIVE TAPE

Create two tape lines.

- (A) Place the first tape line on the back of the face, from the nose hole to the top of the head and over the tab.
- (B) Place the second tape line on the front of face, from above the muzzle to below the top of the head.



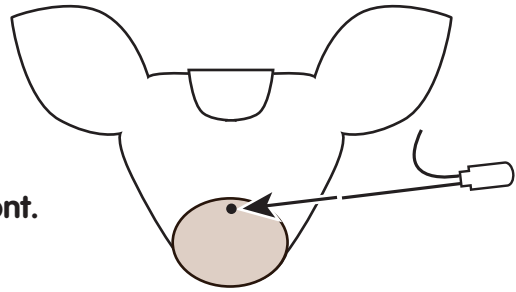
(BACK)



(FRONT)

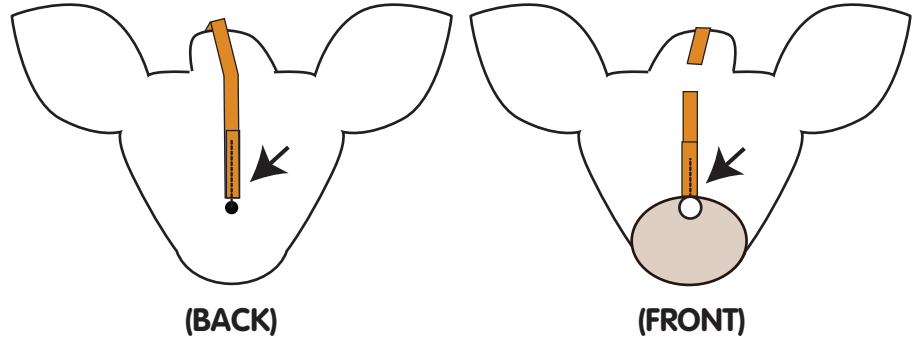
5 **INSERT LED THROUGH MUZZLE on FACE**

Bend the shorter, negative (-) LEG leg up. Keep in front. Insert the long, positive (+) LED leg through the hole.



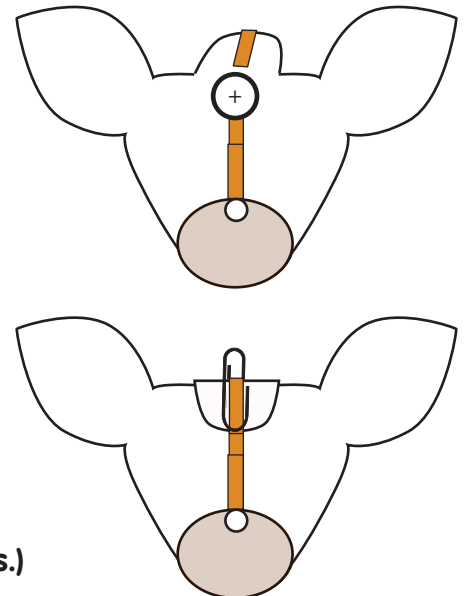
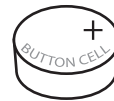
6 **CONNECT LED LEGS to FACE**

Stick both legs in place over existing tape lines with additional conductive tape.



7 **ADD BATTERY to TOP**

Place battery within the fold of tab at top of face. The positive side of the battery with words, marked "+" must face up.



8 **PAPERCLIP the BATTERY**

Position paperclip vertically so that it holds battery between the fold of paper.



The nose should light up!

If not, check:

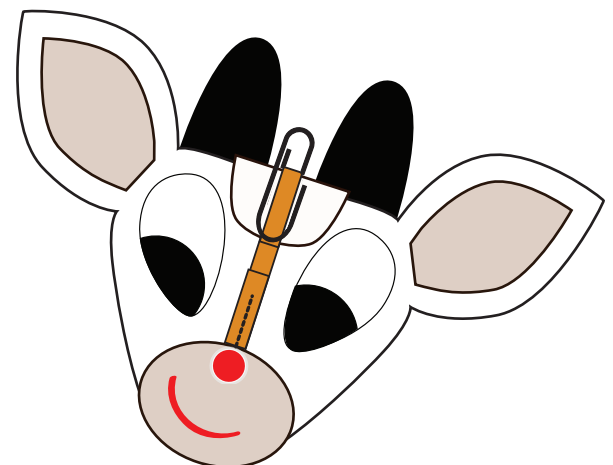
- Flip battery over. (The LED legs may have been put in backwards.)
- Make sure conductive tape extends all the way to touch contact points of LED and battery.
- Make sure the separate lines of tape by the battery aren't touching. (That could create a short circuit.)

9 **DECORATE YOUR DEER**

Glue or tape the eyes and ears to the front of the face. Glue or tape the antlers on the back of the head.

Use a marker or crayon to add a smile.
