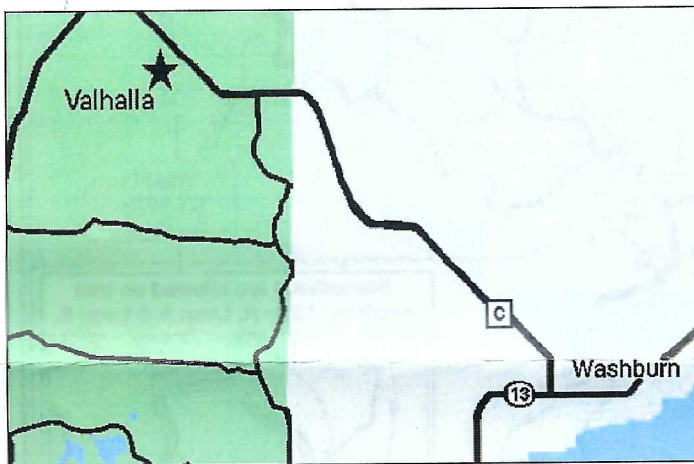

- Summer non-motorized trails for hiking, biking, and horseback riding
- Groomed trails in the winter for snowshoeing, skate skiing, and classic skiing
- Motorized trails for ATVs that are groomed for snowmobiles during the winter months
- A daily fee is charged for this area



Description

Mount Valhalla has a rich history and was developed as a Winter Sports Complex in the early 1930's. It is nestled amongst tree covered rolling hills. This area encompasses both motorized and non-motorized trail systems meandering through hardwood and pine forests. Sledding near the Chalet has been enjoyed by many generations.

Location: Off Co. Hwy C.

From US Highway 13, drive west on County Hwy C for 8.5 miles. Parking lot is on the left (south) side of the highway.

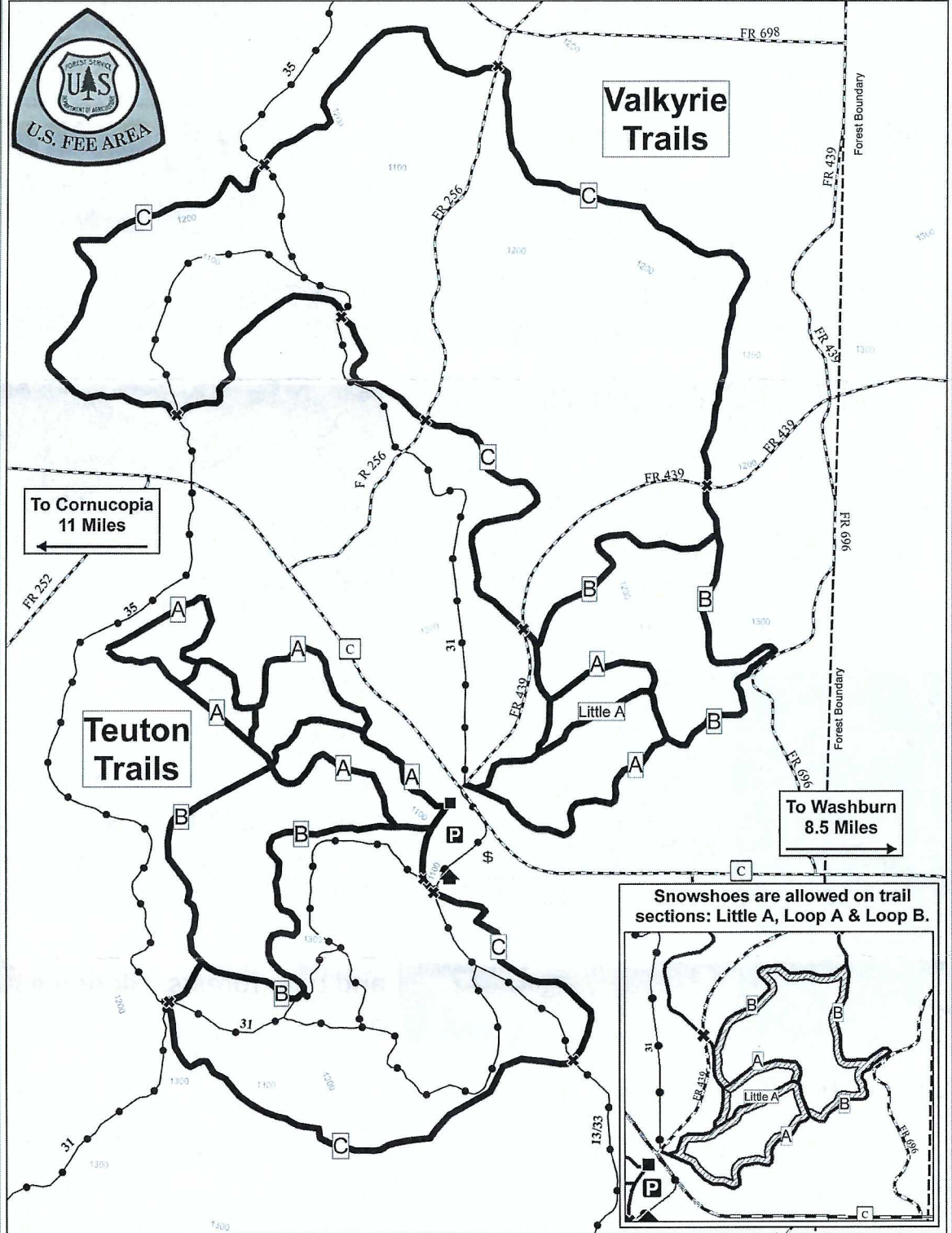

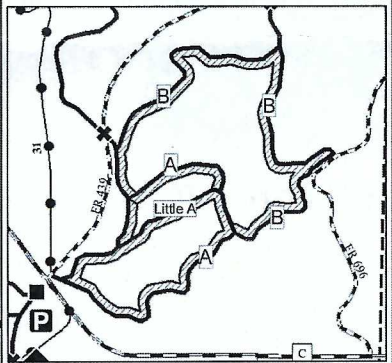
