The 2021 Winter-Reed *Partnership Honoree:* Deborah Fay Bryant



When Deborah Bryant became the First Lady of Mississippi in 2008 she found herself in an entirely new role. As First Lady, Deborah saw her career in health care come to a close, while moving into the business world, where she remains active.

In Deborah's own words, "By 2012, our children in Mississippi were falling behind the rest of the nation in reading even with all the good work others had done before us. Our hope was to build on those labors and make a visible difference for our children." She created and accepted the challenge of visiting each of Mississippi's 82 counties – and stopping by at least one school in each county! During those visits Deborah read to students at each school.



The "Read Across Mississippi Tour" reached children from the Coast to the Capital, from the Delta to the Hills, and all points in between. In those classrooms Deborah read to thousands of children. She made sure to hug each of them before leaving the school. She says "I hugged every child I read to, and in some cases hugged every child in an entire school; one in particular over 400 students. I wanted every child to know they were precious and mattered."



Soon Deborah's visits became the highlight of the school's year. She also left a collection of children's books with each visit that had been donated by caring patrons of the program.

When Governor Bryant left office, Deborah recalls, "After eight years of all of us working together we saw dramatic increases in reading scores. When we left office our fourth graders were leading the nation in advancement in reading scores on the National Report Card. I hope I had some small part joining with parents, teachers, and administration in achieving this goal."

About the Award:

For more than 40 years, Gov. William Winter and the late Jack Reed, Sr., were driving forces on behalf of public education in Mississippi. Through the years, they united in a bipartisan front to promote the need for quality education and consistent, adequate funding of our public education system. In their honor, the Mississippi Association of Partners in Education in 2007 established a perpetual award in their names to be presented annually to promote the ideals and partnership exemplified by their lifelong commitment to education. Since 1984 the Mississippi Association of Partners in Education, a 501 (c)(3), has served as a statewide network of educators and community partners.
