KNITCRATE



An elegant and decadent shawl, featuring rippled Garter stitch borders, lace sections and edging, and sophisticated two-color striping on a traditional triangle shape. This intermediate pattern is suitable for those venturing into lace work for the very first time.

YARN & NEEDLES

US 7 (4.5 mm) 24" circular needle or longer.
Substitute size as necessary to obtain gauge.

2 stitch markers

Toby Roxane Designs Special Sport
100% Superwash Merino Wool
329 yds (300 m) / 100 g
2 skeins used for this project:
MC - City Night, CC - Warm Glow

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

60" (152.5 cm) wide
25" (63.5 cm) deep at center

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

GAUGE

19 stitches & 28 rows = 4" (10 cm) stockinette
stitch, after blocking.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS - right side

WS - wrong side

pm - place marker

slm - slip marker

st(s) - stitch(es)

CO - cast on

BO - bind off

YO - yarn over

MC - main color

CC - contrast color

k2tog - knit two stitches together

tbl - through the back loop

s2kp - slip 2 sts as if to k2tog, k1, pass slipped sts over

ssk - slip, slip, knit two slipped stitches together

NOTES

When instructed to work in Stockinette stitch, work the following two rows as many times as specified:

RS - K2, yo, knit to m, yo, slm, k1, slm, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

WS - K2, yo, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

When instructed to work in Garter stitch, work the following two rows as many times as specified:

RS - K2, yo, knit to m, yo, slm, k1, slm, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

WS - K2, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

When instructed to change colors, you do not need to break the color no longer in use--you may carry it up the side of your work, unless directed otherwise.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using MC, CO 2 sts.

Knit 6 rows. At the end of the last row, do not turn work. Rotate work 90 degrees clockwise, pick up and knit 3 sts along side edge, then rotate work 90 degrees again, pick up and knit 2 sts along CO edge. 7 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2, yo, (p1, pm) twice, p1, yo, k2. 9 sts.

Beginning with a RS row, work in Stockinette stitch (see Notes) for 19 more rows. 67 sts.

Beginning with a WS row, work in Garter stitch for 3 rows. 75 sts

Switch to CC. Beginning with a RS row, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch. 81 sts

Work Rows 1 - 4 of Lace Chart. 86 sts.

Break CC; switch to MC. Beginning with a RS row, work 4 rows in Garter stitch. 98 sts.

Beginning with a RS row, work 19 rows in Stockinette stitch. 156 sts.

Beginning with a WS row, work 3 rows in Garter stitch. 164 sts.

Switch to CC. Beginning with a RS row, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch. 170 sts.

Work Rows 1 - 8 of Lace Chart. 194 sts.

Break CC; switch to MC. Beginning with a RS row, work 4 rows in Garter stitch. 206 sts.

Beginning with a RS row, work 31 rows in Stockinette stitch. 300 sts.

Beginning with a WS row, work 3 rows in Garter stitch. 308 sts.

Break MC; switch to CC. Beginning with a RS row, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch. 314 sts.

Work Rows 1 - 19 of Lace Chart. 372 sts.

Work 1 Garter stitch WS row.

BO all sts loosely as follows: *K2tog tbl, place st on right-hand needle back onto left-hand needle. Repeat from * until 1 st remains. Break yarn and pull through.

Block, weave in ends, and wear proudly!
