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The Weekender Slouch Hat was inspired by fast paced weekends filled with laughter and fun. It is super slouchy and made top down using the classic granny stitch pattern. This hat is perfect both for a casual run or gift giving. Make this accessory for family and friends just in time for the transitioning weather.

Hook:

US H/8 (5 mm) and US K/10.5 (6.5 mm), or sizes needed to meet gauge $% \lambda = 0.011$

Yarn: Uru Yarn Electric 40% Alpaca, 30% Wool, 30% Suri Alpaca 150 yards (137m) / 100g 195 (240) yds (178 (219) m) used / 2 skeins needed for all sizes With larger hook, 15 dc \times 9 rnds = 4" (10 cm) in Granny Stripe Pattern in the round.

Finished Sizes: 10 (12)" (25 (30)cm) wide x 9 (11)" (23 (28)cm) tall to fit heads 18-20 (22-24)" (46-51 (56-61)cm) circumference

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO: back loop only ch: chain dc: double crochet inc: increase mc: magic circle rnd(s): round(s) sc: single crochet
sc2tog: single crochet two together
sl st: slip stitch
sp(s): space(s)
st(s): stitch(es)

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Increase (inc): (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same stitch/space

NOTES

- Pattern is worked top down with joined and turned rounds.
- Each round is joined by a slip stitch.
- Granny pattern is worked in the chain-2 spaces and in the space between two dc clusters for all rounds.
- Chain 3 counts as first dc for all rounds.
- Chain 1 counts as a stitch for Rounds 19 (size 1) and 21 (size 2) only.
- Sc2tog from ribbing does not count as a stitch.
- Ribbing has negative ease of up to 1" (2.5cm).

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INSTRUCTIONS

Hat Body

With larger hook, make magic circle.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, in MC, 2 dc, ch 2, (3 dc, ch 2) four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (15 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in first ch-2 sp, inc in next ch-2 sp four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (30 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, inc in next ch-2 sp, (3 dc in next sp, inc in next ch-2 sp) four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (45 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, inc in next sp, (3 dc in next sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, inc in next sp) four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (60 dc)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in next sp, inc in next sp, (3 dc in next sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in next sp, inc in next sp) four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (75 dc)

Size 1 Only

Rnd 6: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, (3 dc in each of next four sps, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) four times, 3 dc in each of last three sps, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn.

Rnd 7: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in each sp around, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn.

Rnds 8-18: Repeat Rnd 7.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, sc in each dc around, join to beginning ch-1, turn. (75 sc)

Size 2 Only

Rnd 6: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in each of next two sps, inc in

next sp, (3 dc in next sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, 3 dc in each of next two sps, inc in next sp) four times, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn. (90 dc)

Rnd 7: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, (3 dc in each of next five sps, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) four times, 3 dc in each of last four sps, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn.

Rnd 8: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in each sp around, join to top ch of beginning ch-3, turn.

Rnds 9-20: Repeat Rnd 8.

Rnd 21: Ch 1, sc in each dc around, join to beginning ch-1, turn. (90 sc)

Applied Ribbing -All Sizes

With smaller hook, ch 7.

Row 1: Working perpendicular to Hat Body, sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across, sc2tog over the next 2 sc on Hat Body, turn. (6 sc, 1 sc2tog)

Row 2: Sc BLO in each st across, turn. (6 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc BLO in each st across, sc2tog next 2 sc on Hat Body, turn. (6 sc, 1 sc2tog)

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 to end. SI st first and last row together to seam. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.
