





The delicious menu is the main Spring Banquet attraction. Add a program, a speaker or local entertainment. The occasion should be comfortable and social.

Plan wisely!

One popular Spring tradition is the Mother and Daughter Banquet. Many occasions feature banquets. Evening events, women's programs, holiday gatherings, annual retreats, summer picnics and even family church banquets.



Good Food and Funny Conversations Are the Fondest Memories of a Party!

Be Casual: A casual party is a fun and games event where people mix for sparkling conversation, good food and laughter. Some parties tend to be informal and hosts do not go to extra trouble to decorate. Sometimes these parties do not have to be planned at all.

While party games were once wildly popular, there are groups who do not enjoy a lot of organized activity. Create a highly enjoyable experience.

The activities should fit the needs of guests.

Be Formal: A fancy party requires detailed planning to handle the program, publicity, decorating, refreshments and clean up. It is a great party if you create your own fun to create amazing memories.

You Really Can Do Whatever You Want!

The smallest details make the biggest impression. Wild flowers on a table, small table gifts, background music, greeters and smiles other make guests feel welcome, special and pampered.

Create a memory!


When the party is over, clean up begins. The party is not complete until the church is in order. Encourage the team to remove their personal items immediately. Stay to help with kitchen clean up.

Is there a set fee? If not, give a generous monetary gift including traveling Think about the time they invest in preparation, travel and costs. presentation. Be generous.

Stay In Touch

Send a letter, make a telephone call and use the internet. Include highway directions, arrival time, group size, time limit, lodging information and specific personal details. **Gracious communication.**

Care and Feeding

Be a friend! Provide a specific hostess who handles introductions, sits with and converses with the guest at dinner and gives the speaker a sense of belonging.

It is disquieting for a guest speaker to enter a room of strangers, speak about personal and spiritual issues and leave feeling like everyone is still a stranger.

Include expenses from the time the speaker leaves home until the event is done. If more meals are required, host or pay accordingly.

PREVIE "Show hospitality to one another...."

Stay with the speaker until their departure. Thank that person from your heart.

lt's In The Details

Invitations, posters, registration forms, programs, handouts and centerpieces should relate to the theme. Use the same colors, scripture, picture or logo on every piece of publicity.

Involve helpers in the planning stages. They don't have to be on the planning team. Assign tasks and small speaking parts.

Ask as many people as possible to participate in the formal program.

Participants attend and invite others.

Many hands make light work.

Cut stress with more help.

Even More Fun!

Award prizes and give gifts for various games. Feature a Chinese Auction the guests can browse and deposit tickets for gifts of their choice. Enjoy the company of friends.

Invite Every Gal!

Send invitations. When a community wide event is planned, place posters in local restaurants, business offices. Insert invitations in the weekly worship folder and in the monthly church newsletter.

Don't forget...One of the best places to put posters is in the Ladies Room at church and in community businesses. If a local business hesitates to put yet another community event poster in their window, suggest their ladies room as a great "out of the way" place!

Choose the best of our ideas to get started.

Plant your own daisies and decorate your own soul Instead of waiting for someone else to bring you flowers.

Artistic, visually creative people take the responsibility to turn the room into a work of art. If there is no team, decorate simply at each table. You cannot go wrong!

Use color and light to best advantage.

From tables to cheerful displays, the entire room should feature greenery, flowers, bright Spring colors. Individual events look different depending on available items.

The best fun happens when guests arrive and the Spring Gala theme comes to life with table elegance, games, speakers, prizes and music!

Let guests view all table decorations before they are seated.

Spring Gala Hot Tips!

Choose coordinating colors as a basic foundation. Consider lime green table coverings and yellow daffodils. Mix white daisies with other wild flowers like dandelions. Other colors that make the theme come to life: lime green, salmon, neon pink, lavender, orange.

Programs: Print covers in a complimentary color. Create your own printed information based on local details. Each place setting features a program placed near the plate. Add a ribbon or bow.

ADD TABLE SPARKLE WITH CANDLES, BALLOONS, CRYSTAL GLASSES COLORFUL HANDMADE TISSUE FLOWERS.

Catch the Eye: Antique garden tools, garden gloves, candles in crystal glasses, butterflies or other available items. Shop for daisy stickers on Google! Search "Spring Banquet Images". **Wow! The ideas you find!**

Highlight: Add one silk daisy to the top of each napkin setting. For a touch of whimsey wrap a beaded stretch bracelet around the napkin with a narrow yellow ribbon bow on the bracelet.

Serve lemonade with white straws and spring flowers stuck in the straws.

Choose the style before gathering items. From casual burlap accessories to formal elegant crystal, Your choice will be delightful!

P Everything Is Springing Up!

Feature live flowers. Wrap a container in colorful fabric tied with a wide, flowing ribbon. Plain mason jars bring wild flowers to life. If live flowers are not an option, mix silk flower varieties at a local dollar/discount store.

HOT TIP:

CENTERPIECE CONTAINERS: METAL BUCKETS OR CERAMIC BOWLS OR WHITE BOXES WRAPPED IN WIDE RIBBON OR GARDEN WICKER BASKETS.

"Oo-Ah" Factor!

In clear glass containers, feature whole lemons/oranges or clean, smooth river rocks under water.

Tuck flowers and greenery into the underwater base.

HOT TIP - MAYBE?

ADD ONE OR TWO GOLDFISH TO CLEAR GLASS BOWLS WITH FLOWER HEADS FLOATING ON SURFACE. GIVE THEM GOOD HOMES AFTER THE BANQUET!

Consider a Contemporary Stunner: Arrange three tall, square or rectangle clear glass vases. Spray paint tree twigs white and place them in the vases. Add one large Spring flower with water to each vase.

Option: Attach one or two silk butterflies to one of the twigs.

HOT TIP: CLEAR VASES ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$1 AT LOCAL DOLLAR STORES.

Consider a Balloon Blast: The entire room comes to life when colorful balloons fly high from each table. Fill the **floor** with various spring color balloons. Don't worry, floor balloons move aside easily as people walk. The more balloons on the floor, the better effect.

So festive and pretty! The perfect Spring Gala touch!


PREVIETable Dessert Towers Y

Small, round layer cakes, frosted white and decorated with silk flowers become delightful table centerpiece desserts.

The cakes should serve the people seated at each table. If desired, add frosting flowers on top and around the edges of the cake! Include one cake server with a colorful bow.

Program Props

See program segments for prop tips. Sometimes nothing is needed.

FRESH FLOWERS! PLANTS! BUTTERFLIES! LADY BUGS! BUNNIES!

Do You Have a Stage?

Place floor plants behind the speaker's podium. Two large palms or trees or live floor plants work well. No large plants? Place two tall, narrow plant stands behind the podium for fresh spring flower vases or leafy ferns.

Make large, silk flowery bouquets that include Spring flowers, pearls, ribbon and light greens. Tie with ribbons and place in baskets on stands near the program staging area.

Tuck spring flowers into plants. Scatter silk butterflies or lady bugs with clips on the plants. Add colorful flowing ribbon bows.

Lighting: Light the stage displays from the floor with white twinkle lights or small spotlights.

Options: Add a bit of white picket fence, garden tools, large tissue flowers.

HOT TIP:

BASKETS, DOLLS, PLUSH RABBITS,

Set up a simple Spring scene where photographs are taken. Guests may choose to participate or just watch the fun unfold before and after the program.

Shop Local: Ask businesses and restaurants to donate small gifts or gift cards.

Dollar Store: picture frames, note holders, lamps, cosmetic bags, pill organizers, key chains, potted plants, candles and costume jewelry. Offer fun gifts for the littlest gals...stuffed animals, coloring books or fingernail polish!

Create lovely gift baskets with these inexpensive items.

Everyone enjoys an event where people are talking laughing, light and temperature is controlled, music sets the mood.

tables are inviting

No one enjoys going to a party where everyone remains a stranger, little conversation occurs and a subdued mood becomes awkward.

Greet guests cordially, attach Flowery name tags and direct them to the party area. Encourage guests to browse around the room as the crowd gathers. Help them find their assigned table. Point out rest rooms and conveniences.

Get acquainted with simple table activities. Place conversation starters under plates. Scatter pens and place paper puzzles or short games in obvious places so guests can work together to win a table prize.

Enthusiastic group singing encourages togetherness. Play a few table games as ice breakers. This is the time for generous hospitality and smiles.

Friendships Have Small Beginnings!

Seat guests in small groups. Offer opportunities to make intimate contact with table friends.

Devise activities that can be done in pairs or fours.

Enjoy The Journey!

Mix interactive and quiet activities. Some activities should require a mental challenge with pencil and paper, group skits and sometimes activities for the whole group.

Choose what your group does best!

A Good Beginning Makes a Good Ending!

Complete group activities before dinner and continue the fun after the meal.

Add spiritual and inspirational thoughts near the end.

"Goodbye, Farewell, Amen!"

Finish strong with a whole group activity: Singing, listening to a story, letting people share a memory or what they enjoyed. Present an inspirational spiritual closing with a serious skit or talk, songs, hymns, praise choruses, sharing and a benediction featuring a friendship prayer circle.

LEA Juicy Orange Punch

1 can frozen orange juice
2 ½ cans water 1-2 liter Sprite
1 container of orange sherbet
Thin slices of oranges on top!

- 1. In a pitcher, combine orange juice concentrate and cans of water.
 - 2. Freeze for about 4 hours until slushy.
- 3. In the punch bowl, add orange juice and layer of sherbet.
 - Pour Sprite over top of sherbet and stir just a bit so it gets nice and frothy on top.
 - 5. Top with thin slices of oranges.
 - 6. Serve immediately

Fresh Fruit 'Cupcake'

Choose a variety of fresh fruits cut into small portions placed in a miniature paper cup. Include a mixture of apple slice, cherry, diced cantaloupe, mini pineapple tidbits, banana, strawberries, blueberries.

Yummy Fruit Dip: 8 oz. Whipped Topping, 3 oz. Cream cheese, 7 oz. Marshmallow creme. Spoon into bottom of liner and fill with fruit.

Nuts And Bolts Party Mix

2 C. Corn Chex 2 C. Rice Chex 2 C. Cheerios 2 C. Thin pretzels 2 C. Blanched peanuts 3 T. Salad oil 10 T. Butter 4 T. Worcestershire Sauce ½ t. seasoned salt ½ t. garlic powder

Oven: 225 degrees In baking dish, mix cereals, pretzels, peanuts; set aside. On medium head blend oil, butter, sauce, salt, garlic until butter is melted and spices are blended. Pour seasoning mixture over cereal mixture and stir until completely coated with seasoning.

Bake 1 hour, stirring every 20 minutes to make sure it does not burn. Remove from oven and cool completely before storing in an airtight container. Fill clear plastic cups with individual portions.

Crunchy Veggie Treat

Cut mini celery, cucumber slices, broccoli, cauliflower, asparagus, dilly beans and carrot sticks that fit into doubled cupcake liners. Spoon Ranch Dip into the liners before placing veggies on top.

Choose veggies that can be cut into small pieces for easy dipping.

Ham and Turkey Roll Ups

Roll deli ham and turkey in cream cheese and place upright with parsley or celery tops for garnish.

Shrimp

Spoon cocktail sauce into liner and place one shrimp on top. Option: For children, consider one chicken nugget on top of ketchup.





Fluffy Pink Lemonade Pie (With Pretzel Crust)

Crust: 2 Cups broken pretzels (about 4 oz) 1/4 cup sugar ½ cup butter or margarine, melted



1 container (8 oz) frozen whipped topping thawed

Garnish: Lemon slices, cut into fourths

350 degree oven. Crush pretzels and sugar in food processor, drizzle melted butter and mix well. Press crust in ungreased baking dish. Bake 5-8 minutes until golden brown. Cool completely.

Cream cheese in large bowl, microwave until well softened. Stir until smooth. Beat dry pudding mix into cream cheese with mixer until well mixed. Add lemonade concentrate and food color. Make your favorite sugar cookie. Cut in the shape of large flowers. Frost with springtime pastel colors. Depending on cookie sizes, serve one or two on a yellow or green dessert plate with vanilla ice cream.

Strawberry Ice Cream

Serve strawberry ice cream in a small glass bowl. Top with real strawberries and a silk Spring flower head tucked into the side.

Cherry Cheesecake

Make your favorite cheesecake recipe and use cherry pie filling as the fruit of choice topping.

Frosted Flower Cupcakes

Spring Gala #3:

Bugs Are Back In Town

Speakers: Two people, One person explains the bug. One person explains the remedies.

This is a Public Service Announcement to raise awareness of and changing public attitudes and behavior toward a social issue.

Bugs Are Back In Town! We call it 'the invasion'. Spring has many wonderful qualities but bugs is not one of them. In fact, there are many people who have Entomophobia, which is an excessive or unrealistic for of one or more insects.



For Instance:

1. House Flies: This nasty little bug comes in sizes from teeny tiny to big, fat and ugly. They get into the house and land their filthy wings on whatever food is hanging out on the kitchen counter. They squeeze in between the screen and window. When you open it to catch the Spring breeze they zip past you and have free range.

Remedy: Admit it. Opening the door and hoping they fly out is not an option. In reality, you open the door and five more flies join them. Remedy: There is the "swat and squish" method~my personal favorite. Usually blood is involved. Keep those fly swatters, mosquito spray and citronella candles handy. The ever popular electric bug zappers are pricey but solve bug issues. These electric killers mean you have to have the stomach to listen to the buzz of death. Pick your poison, folks.



3. Bees, Wasps, Yellow Jackets: Nobody likes a bug with attitude. They build their nests in yards and on houses. They work their way into attic walls to ensure the safety of their young. They sting! They are a great example of hard work. We know it because the Bible tells us:

"Go to the ant, thou sluggard: consider her ways and be wise."



Spring Gala #4:

The Need...The Need For Seed Garden Shed Skit Preparation

Speaker: One person. **Optional:** Assistant NO MEMORIZATION NEEDED.

Ask the children to come to the table and sit on the floor to watch the surgery.

Costume: Dress as a dedicated gardener. Wear jeans, work shirt, tennis shoes, full apron, garden gloves, sunglasses, gardening hat.

Assistant: When a Garden Shed assistant is included, that person reads the segments printed in italics.

Props/Garden Shed Operating Room: Seed packets, One large watermelon (hollowed out with hole that can open and close), tongs, table covered with white sheet, garden tools.

Preparation: Gather items before the event. Use these suggestions or create your own 'garden operating room' as desired.

White sheet covered table: The table can be as small as a foldable card table or larger as available. Display tongs and tools like a garden shed operating room instruments.

Line the good 'items' on the table that will be inserted in the watermelon.

Seed Packets and Watermelon: The skit involves taking bad things out of the watermelon and replacing them with good items. Begin skit with seed packets on table and watermelon hidden under the table in a basket or Rubbermaid tub. Cut a good sized hole in side of watermelon, scrape out enough fruit to fit items inside. Fill with the 'bad' items. Close hole.

HOT TIP

If your grocery store does not have watermelon in stock, choose another large fruit that can be opened and scooped out for the 'operation.'

These are the simple items suggested for the Garden Shed Melon Operation. Gather them before the event. If desired, place in small zip lock bags to protect them from the moisture of the melon.

SEEDS/SEED PACKETS: Purchase a variety of seed packets OR scoop seed from the melon which has been cut open before the event.

Bad Items To Be Removed

SMALL ROCK: Any sized pebble or rock may be inserted into the melon.

SMALL MIRROR: Find a small mirror of any shape. Place in zip lock bag to protec it.

DOLLAR BILL: Place a dollar bill in a zip lock bag to protect it.

BLACK HEART: Cut out a paper or fabric black heart. Place in a zip lock bag to protect it.

Good Items To Be Inserted

PEACE DOVE: Optional white paper cutout of a bird or if a small white ceramic bird is available.

SMALL TWIG: Pull a 'no cost' twig from a nearby tree or bush. It must fit inside the melon.

GOD'S WORD: Write John 3:16 on a large paper heart. Fold it and place it carefully inside the melon.

JUMBO WHITE HEART WITH BAND-AIDS: Cut a jumbo white heart to cover the outer watermelon 'wound' made by the cut. At the conclusion, close the melon, place white heard like a bandage and attach it with large band-aids.

Don't Forget!

All the bad and good items should be removed and replaced using kitchen tongs as an Operating Room tool.

Skit:

The Need...The Need For Seed In The Garden Shed



Welcome to the Garden Shed. We invite you to observe a delicate operation. Learn what makes a delicious life filled with faith, love and joy through Jesus. Watch and be amazed!

SEEDS: Garden Shed Spring plantings begin with seeds. These seeds are filled with future garden creations. We have A Need ... A Need for Seed. Without seeds there is no life.

The Plan: With water, right temperature and right location the seed grows. It becomes a seedling. Roots push down into the ground to get water and minerals. That is the story of Spring.

Each of us started life as a seed. So tiny no one could see us except God who created us with all our potential already inside us.

NOT FOR USE

WATERMELON: We have a Garden Shed problem. (Take watermelon from container and display on the table.) To the untrained eye, this watermelon looks strong, healthy and ready to eat like the watermelons that grow all summer in gardens and fields.

This garden beauty is rotting from the inside. Outside looks great, inside needs help. Are you ready for the procedure?

The problem appears to be in the very heart of this melon. You can see scars from past operations. We will open this area and take a look inside. Open Heart Surgery begins.

Scalpel!

The melon won't feel anything. However, it IS uncomfortable for people when anyone looks inside them. There is hidden heart disease. (Lift off rind and place it on the table next to the patient.)

Tongs!



SMALL ROCK: (Pull out rock with tongs.) This is totally out of place. A rock must be removed right away. It appears this heart condition has been going on for some time.

If this melon is to be restored, the rock has to go. People must let go of their hardened heart to be softened to a loving God.

SMALL MIRROR: This can't be good. What a surprising item to pull from a melon. Did a mirror fall into the field and distract the melon?

God's Word says, "If a person just listens and doesn't obey, he is like a man looking at his face in a mirror: As soon as he walks away, he can't see himself anymore or remember what he looks like."

James 1:23-24 TM

DOLLAR BILL: I might have known! Money! There is always money in the heart of any operation.

God's Word says: "A rich man should be glad that his riches mean nothing to the Lord, for he will soon be gone, like a flower that has lost its beauty and fades away....."

James 1:10-11 TM

BLACK HEART: (Paper black heart) This situation is worse than I suspected. This melon needs an immediate heart transplant. His heart is black as coal. It is so full of rot that it cannot be saved.

God's Word says: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Romans 3:23

That is the first half of the Garden Shed operation. It isn't enough to remove the heart disease.

I must replace it with good things to help this melon survive and be ready for harvest time. This is the most delicate part of the operation and I beg for absolute silence.

PEACE DOVE: (White paper shape of bird) I must carefully place the Peace of Christ inside the patient as close to the heart as possible.

Jesus said, "I am leaving you with a gift, peace of mind and heart! And the peace I give isn't fragile like the peace the world gives. So don't be troubled or afraid."

John 14:27

SMALL TWIG: I am placing a healthy, living vine inside this melon. The melon flesh is nice and pink and the melon is quite watery and filled with seeds. The vine should attach nicely and the melon should continue to grow.

Jesus said, "I am the Vine, you are the branches. Whoever lives in me and I in him shall produce a large crop of fruit." John 15:1

GOD'S WORD: (John 3:16 on small, white paper heart) I am placing God's wisdom inside this melon. Without it, this melon will not grow any bigger. Knowing God loves each person and sent Jesus to show us the way to Heaven is most important thing we must have in our hearts.

God's Word says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life."

John 3:16

LARGE WHITE HEART and BAND-AIDS: (Cut out a large white paper heart. Tape to the outside of the melon.) Now we carefully close this melon. The crucial part of open heart surgery is next. Healing. The bad things are removed and the good things have replaced them. This melon's heart is full.

(Replace outside of melon rind.) We have done all we can. We now cover all these good items with a pure, white heart. This is the actual Heart Transplant. Melons go back to the field to bask in the sunshine and rain to grow strong from seed to harvest.

People ask Jesus to become their Lord and Savior. It appears there must be an operation and a healing season and then a harvest for melons and for people. From Spring to Harvest God cares for His creation.

It is time to tuck our watermelon away for the healing season. The next time you eat a delicious slice of watermelon, remember that to grow strong from Spring to Harvest, get rid of the things that hinder us and replace them with the things God says are good.




This ends our "Spring Gala" and it's still Spring! We featured many of the quotes and short sayings that welcome spring. Did it make you feel "Spring-y"?
