1. CHARCOAL BRICK

Mungyo Gallery Artists Soft Pastels in Black gives a dark smooth black.

2. CHARCOAL PENCIL

I only use *General Charcoal Pencils*. I love the 2B, 4B and 6B. This is a perfect starter kit.

3. WHITE ERASER

Any white eraser will do. I use *Staedtler* and the Staple Business Depot brand.

4. X-ACTO KNIFE

Any X-acto knife will do. I use this for cutting my eraser to keep it sharp.

5. PAPER STOMP

These are great for blending in tight spaces and creating soft lines. *This is a nice kit.*

PAPER

Having good quality paper is an absolute must. While you can create beautiful work on standard white printing paper, it is more likely to bend and it will change colour over time. I like to work on acid free paper that is at least 90lb. My current favourite is a 140lb Canson watercolour paper that you can purchase [here](#).
