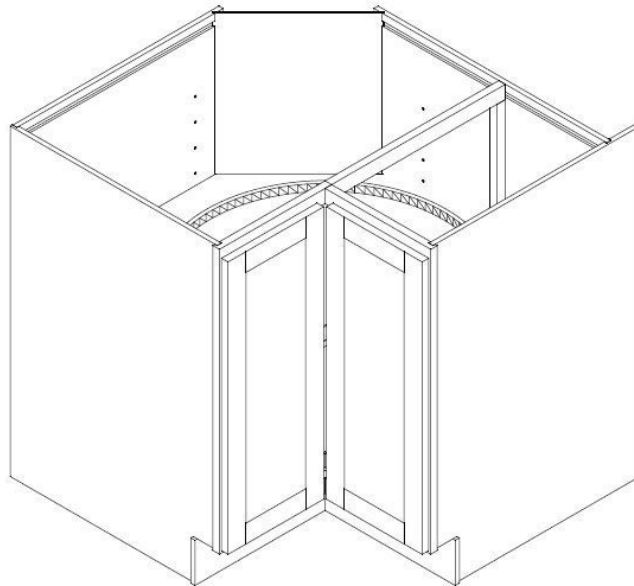

Before the assembly begins, check that all appropriate and required plumbing and electrical connections exist.




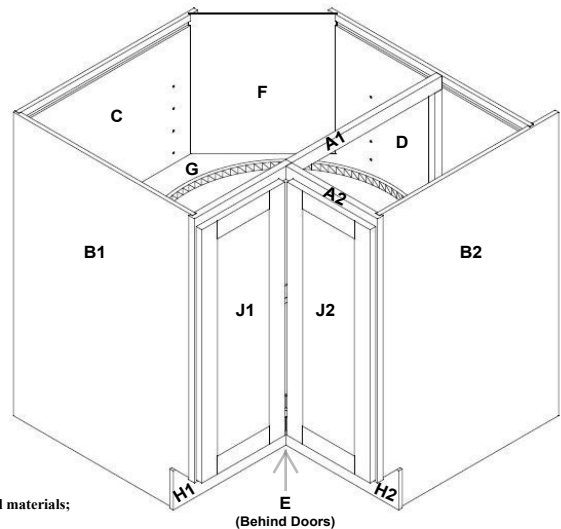

The materials listing above are for the largest unit in this instruction set. Smaller units may require less hardware and materials; therefore, your item may contain a smaller number of each.



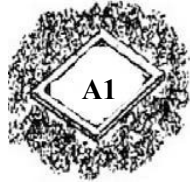
► Instructions:

- 1. Assembling the Door Set:** Place two doors (**J1&J2**) on a flat surface and align them from the pilot holes. Attach them together using the invisible hinge sets (**f**) and the provided screws, and set aside.



(Note: If the doors are already assembled, please continue to Step 2)

- 2. Place face frame (A1)** face down on a flat soft working surface (**Figure 1**).



- 3. Insert left side panel (B1)** into the grooves of face frame (**A1**) on the magnetic latch side. Align the plastic half part of the cam lock connectors. Make sure it fits and lock connectors with screwdriver by turning the screw located on the cam lock connector to the right 180° (**Figure 2**) Stand up side panel up right at this time. (**Figure 3**)

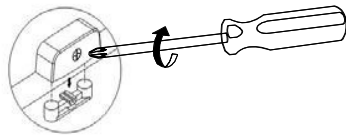

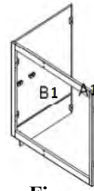

- 4. Insert the bottom (E)** with turntable through face frame resting it in the grooves provided on the side panel. *(Note: If the turntables are not assembled to the bottom and shelf, go ahead and attach them at this time before completing Step 4.)*

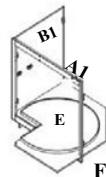

- 5. Insert Right Rear Side Panel (D)** connect with the face frame (**A1**). Insert Left Rear Side Panel (**C**) (**Figure 5**) Align the cam lock connectors and lock.

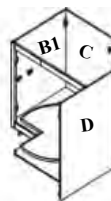

- 6. Place the back panel (E)** connect with rear side panels and align the cam lock connectors. (**Figure 6**) Align the cam lock connectors and lock.

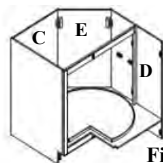

- 7. Insert shelf with turntable (G)** into position, align the cam locks under the shelf and lock. (**Figure 7**)

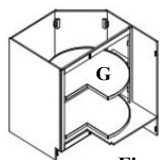

- 8. Place the Right Side Panel (B2)** and align the cam lock connectors with right rear side panel. **(Figure 8)** Lock the cam lock connectors. Place the Short Frame (A2) and align the cam lock connectors with the side panel (B2) and frame (A1) and lock the cam lock connectors.

- 9. Place and attach door assembly (J)** from Step 1 onto face frame (A2) using door hinges (g) and screws (d) **(Figure 9)**
 Attach the short toe kick (H2) to long toe-kick (H1) with cam locks, then put onto the cabinet under the door. Make sure that all fit and lock the cam lock connectors. Reposition the cabinet, laying it on the back panel, **(Figure 10)** lock cam locks to the frame under the door. Return cabinet to upright position.

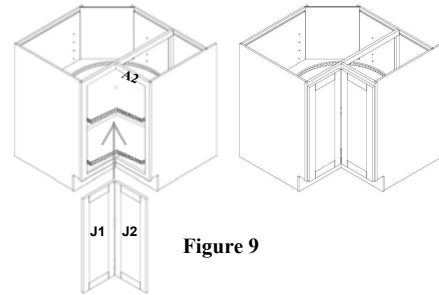
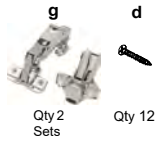

- 10. Installing the Corner Braces (Figures 11&12):** Position and insert the 5 plastic corner braces (b) in the locations shown in **(Figures 11&12)** secure them with 1/2" screws (c). Install round buttons (a) onto the doors where they contact the frames.

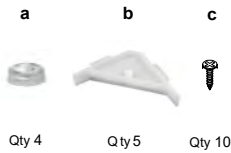

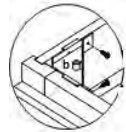

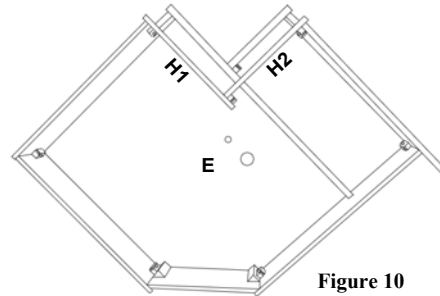

► Maintenance

For daily cleaning, use a dry cloth and a soft liquid cleaner.

Never use abrasive cleaners containing acetone, chlorine or strong bleach. Also, do not use tools as scrapers, metallic brushes, and other products which can scratch or tarnish surfaces.

Under no circumstances should you use chrome cleaner on chrome-plated or brass trim, hinges, handles, sockets etc.

Good ventilation is essential for maintaining the quality and look of this furniture.
