## - Instructions:

1. Place the side panel (A) face down on a flat soft working surface to ensure that the face is not scratched or damaged. (Figure 1).

2. Install the Back Panel, bottom,toe kick: Insert the back panel (B), the bottom (C) and Toe kick (D) into the groove of the side panel (A) and click it into place. (Figure 2)

3. Installing the side panel: Insert the side panel (A) into grooves of back panel (B) \& bottoml (C) and toe kich (D). Press down until they click into place. (Figure 3)

4. Install the frame: Insert the frame ( $E$ ) into the groove of the side panel (A), bottom (C). Press down until they click into place. (Figure4)

5. Assemble 4 plastic corner by screwdriver and 8 screw 1/2" (Figure 5)

6. Assemble 2 hinges into two doors by screwdriver and 4 screw 7/ 15" (Figure 6)

7. Assemble door with hinges to lelf and right of cabinet frame by 4 screw $4 / 5^{\prime \prime}$ (Figure 7)

Maintenance:
