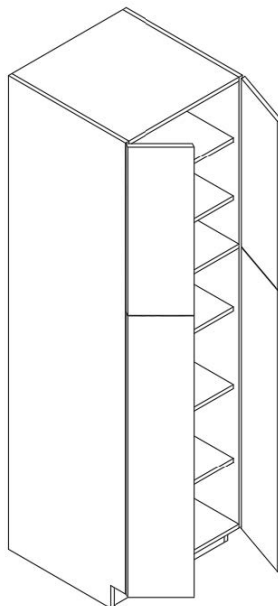


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Before the assembly begins, check that all appropriate and required plumbing and electrical connections exist.





The materials listing above are for the largest unit in this instruction set. Smaller units may require less hardware and materials; therefore, your item may contain a smaller number of each.



► **Instructions:**

1. Unpack box & identify pieces on Page 2. Place side panel (C) onto a soft work surface. (Figure 1)
2. Install Hinge base plates (a) onto side panel into designated holes using screws (d). (Figure 2)
3. Install metal male cam locks (e) into designated holes on side panel (C) and bottom panel (D). Use screwdriver to tighten. Install the wooden dowels (f) into designated holes. (Figure 3)
4. Install the toe kick (F) onto bottom panel (D). (Figure 3)
5. Install Top & Center Panels (D) onto the right side panel (C). (Figure 3)
6. Install locking lugs (e) into designated holes, and then lock them with a screwdriver. (Figure 4)
7. Install side panel (C) onto the assembled panels using the same methods above. (Figure 5)

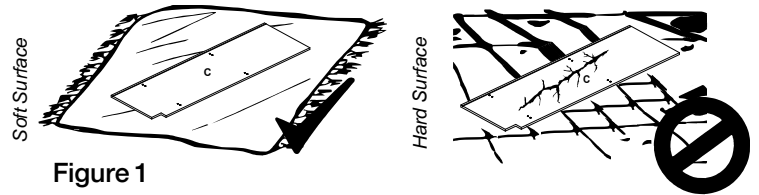

8. Install hinges onto doors into designated holes using screws provided.
 Install doors onto cabinet sides through pre-marked screw holes.
 Install the shelves (E) by using shelf pins (g) in the locations you choose.
 Install the bumpers (b) onto the door corners opposite of the hinges.



► Maintenance

For daily cleaning, use a dry cloth and a soft liquid cleaner.

Never use abrasive cleaners containing acetone, chlorine or strong bleach. Also, do not use tools as scrapers, metallic brushes, and other products which can scratch or tarnish surfaces.

Under no circumstances should you use chrome cleaner on chrome-plated or brass trim, hinges, handles, sockets etc.

Good ventilation is essential for maintaining the quality and look of this furniture.
