Pronto Vanities warrants to the original purchaser of manufacturer's products that from the date of purchase Pronto Vanities products shall be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use. Manufacturer shall only be liable under this warranty if the product is installed and used in a proper manner as specified by manufacturer's instructions as furnished with the product that can be found on the Manufacturer's website under Care & Maintenance file. This product is intended to be installed and used with no modifications. **If the purchaser chooses to modify the product in any way, the warranty will be void. Any incidental loss or damage is your responsibility. This warranty will not apply, and the manufacturer shall have no liability under any of the following circumstances: a) the removal or reinstallation, damage of products from improper installation or use in a manner contrary to Pronto Vanities recommended procedures, b) cracks, chips, or stains in surface, unless caused by defects in material or workmanship, c) slight imperfections; Non-uniform patterns, minor surface irregularities, warping, shade and color variations, and other conditions commonly found in products of nature such as stone and quarried marble or veining techniques in products d) damage caused by abnormal use or abuse, labor, repairs or related expenses, incidental, consequential, or special damages. In no case will the manufacturer be liable on structural defects such as: Irregular graining or colors, specks or impurities in the finished product, hairline scratches, ripples of visible lines in the gel coat. Thermal shock, which means rapid temperature, changes from cold to hot which tends to crack vanity bowls, cuts and abrasions, burns of any nature manufacturer shall not be liable.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR A PROPER INSTALATION

Fully inspect product for damage or defect prior to installation, Warranty DOES NOT COVER COSTS for installation or removal of product.

MATERIALS REQUIRED

1. Clear silicone sealant
2. Faucet
3. Drain connections
4. Hot and cold water supply lines
5. Adjustable wrench
6. Caulking gun
7. Knife or scissors



STEP 1

- * Shim vanity until level
- * Make sure that the cabinet is secure to the wall
- * Try to fit vanity top on cabinet to ensure size and level fit.



STEP 2

- * Remove vanity top
- * Install faucet and supply lines
- * Tighten drain nut until finger tight
- * Do not over tighten



STEP 3

- * Place silicone on the back of the backsplash and to the edge of the cabinet
- * Place vanity top carefully on top of cabinet and press firmly
- * Wipe excess and let dry

Warnings

Cleaning products & chemicals not to be use on engineered quartz: Clorox, hypochlorite bleaches, hydrogen peroxide, Drain-o, lye, Sani-flush, sodium bisulfate compounds, fingernail polish remover, acetone, paint strippers, methylene chloride, Comet, Ajax, abrasive cleaners, lime-a-way, toilet bowl cleaners, and Plumber's Putty. DO NOT use sink to soak items in cleaners, prolonged exposure to cleaners will damage the material and void warranty.

Description

Quartz is a man-made product that is created using natural materials. It is composed of 90% ground quartz and 10% resins and pigments. When combined, they form a hard and durable surface. This hardness, among other properties, is what makes quartz unique among other countertop materials.

How to Clean Engineered Quartz

Due to Pronto Vanity's high density and non-porous qualities, normal cleaning with a damp cloth and mild detergent is all you need to keep your quartz surface looking great. Thoroughly rinse off the soap/mild detergent with hot water after use and dry with soft cloth or paper towel. To avoid dulling the surface shine, make sure to use a non-abrasive cleaner, and thoroughly rinse off with water after use. Those wishing to use environmentally safe cleaners may also use a combination of 50/50 vinegar & water, rinsing afterwards.

- **Cleaning Dried Spills** — Reconstitute the spill with water for several minutes, and then clean the surface with a damp cloth to remove any marks left behind or any residual dirt. Do not use any abrasive pads to clean tougher dirt as abrasives can damage the finish/sheen of your countertops.
- **Metal Marks & Rust** — Special use for spot cleaning ONLY. Because of the abrasive nature of this cleaner, use Bar Keepers Friend Powder only as follows: Place a small amount on damp cloth. Using very light pressure, wipe the area where the marks are in a circular motion, rinsing thoroughly with warm water and dry with soft cloth or paper towel.

CARE & MAINTENANCE *Continued*

Does my vanity have a color variation? Real quartz has natural variations, and natural quartz is used in making engineered quartz, meaning some variation does occur. Side splashes are made separately from vanity tops so color may vary slightly, and Pronto Vanities will not guarantee an exact color match to the vanity top of your choice.

Will my vanity top suffer deflection (warping)? Engineered quartz is made to be extremely durable, including from heat. While engineered quartz is generally highly resistant to warping, in extremely hot environments or when hot items like pots are placed on them they can warp, crack, chip or sustain irreparable color damage. You should store your countertops in an upright position (perpendicular to the floor) unless supported by a cabinet.

What to do if there is a defect? All warranty claims must be made in writing through the original retailer within 30 days of purchase and must include a complete copy of the original purchase receipt. Countertops cannot be returned after installation. Additional information may be requested by the manufacturer/distributor/retailer regarding details included in this warranty.
