



Tesla CyberTruck Windshield HS Installation

1. Install the three large suction cups on the top piece across the bottom.
2. Install and align the bottom piece into the dashboard and side pillars. Don't worry if the bottom piece sags at first, as the top piece will underlap it and hold the bottom piece in place.
3. Before installing the top piece, move the sun visors to the sides.
4. Align the top piece with the headliner and side pillars.
5. Place the sun visors in place for support.
6. Apply pressure to the suction cups to avoid sagging. You will notice the middle suction cup underlapping the bottom piece while the suction cup goes through the large hole to adhere directly to the windshield.
7. To remove the windshield, you might have to flick the three suction cups with your finger because the large suction cups adhere too well to the windshield glass.





Tesla CyberTruck Side HS Installation

Due to the unique design of the Tesla CyberTruck roll up/down feature while opening/closing the doors, installation differs slightly from our typical side window HeatShields.

1. Install the suction cups on the HeatShields.
2. With the door closed, align and tuck the top edge of the HeatShield across the top frame of the window.
3. Apply some pressure on the suction cups. You will notice about a 3-inch overlap across the bottom frame. Now, the Heatshield will hold in place while opening or closing your doors.
