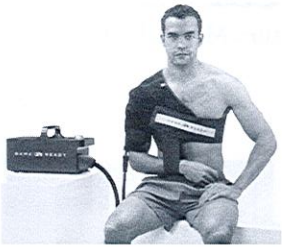

With Game Ready's flexible, circumferential, dual-action wraps and its adjustable settings of time, temperature and compression, you can quickly recover from your injury and get "back in the game."

Continuous Controlled Cold Therapy Unit



With the Continuous Controlled Cold Therapy motorized unit, ice water is circulated through insulated tubing to a pad that is placed over your affected area. Temperature is easily controlled to provide cooling relief throughout your healing and recovery process. This product effectively cools tissue to provide an analgesic effect for acute and post-op pain relief.

By using this cold therapy unit immediately after surgery, you will be taking an important step in speeding up your recovery process.

Static Cold & Compression Wrap



The Static Cold & Compression Wrap gives compression with cold (or heat) to provide optimal control of swelling and pain. This product is simple to use and dry-cold and frostbite proof. Just place the brace in the freezer, then apply. A pump is included with each device to add compression and support, and wraps are available for all extremities. If your insurance does not cover the other two cold therapy products, you may want to select this product for its lower cost.
