## FARM BOOTH GUIDELINES

## All Species

There are limited Farm Booth spaces available in the animal barns to those who are showing, and or exhibiting animals.

- SIZE OF AREA: one pen or up to, but not to exceed a $10 \times 10$ space in the animal barns
- Space includes one 6-8' table and 1 chair
- Application for a Farm Booth does not guarantee a booth space
- Animal registration with entry fees must accompany the Farm Booth request and must be received by $8 / 1$ of current year.
- You will be notified by August $10^{\text {th }}$ if your Farm Booth request was approved.
- Farm Booths will be allotted on a first come basis due to space limitations. Committee chairpersons may use the MFF Vendor Guidelines as needed in the approval process.
- Only 1 space per farm. However, this space can be shared by one or more farms.
- FEE: $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$ Booths maybe in operation through Sunday of Festival..


## ITEMS THAT CAN BE SOLD:

- Fiber/animal items produced on your farm such as raw fleeces, processed fiber i.e. roving, batts, washed locks, dyed fiber, pelts
- Finished goods made from your fiber such as yarn, socks, garments etc.
- Kits made using your fiber, i.e. instructions, and/or tools and the contents MUST BE at least $90 \%$ from your farm.
(PLEASE NOTE: Fertilizer from your farm is not allowed due to biosecurity cautions)
