

# Pygora® Goat Show: Information

**Sat. Aug. 17<sup>th</sup> 2024, 9 AM;** Allegan County Fairground, 150 Douglas St, Allegan, MI 49010; "Pygora" Barn

**Judge:** Ainsley Henry

**Times:** Unless arrangements are made in advance: check-in is between 12 Noon and 7 PM on Friday August 16<sup>th</sup>, release time is Sunday at 4 PM; early release for out-of-state exhibitors is at the discretion of the Show Chair.

**Entry Fees:** \$8.00 per entry per class.

**Pen Fees:** Pens are \$15.00 for either for tack or goats, and at 6'x 6' can accommodate up to 4 adult Pygora goats or 6 kids. Unless specified, pens will be reserved in the doe area. Tack pens will be available as space permits. Hay and straw may be purchased on site; \$ TBD.

## Rules

1. All rules and regulations of the Pygora Breeder's Association will be enforced. PBA Show Rules will be available at the show.
2. All goats must have an Original PBA Certificate of Registration to enter, and Certificates must reflect the correct gender. Pre-registration forms are allowed for goats up to 1 year of age. Certificates must be available during check in and during the show.
3. All Pygora goats 1 year and older must be shown in fleece or with fleece in a box from the current year's latest clip.
4. All goats will be shown under the owner's name as listed on the Registration Certificate, unless a new owner presents the original Registration Certificate along with a signed transfer form dated ≤ 60 days of the show date.
5. All group classes must be registered for in advance - entries will not be accepted on the day of show.
6. **Goats from out-of-state need a veterinarian-issued health certificate completed within 30 days of entry, from animal's state of origin; forms must list each goat's registration number (can be a single document).**
