## Required Accessories:

- 7mm pen mandrel
- 7 mm Drill bit
- 3 pc. bushing set \#1432 (use 2 of the 3 in the set)
- 2 part epoxy glue or insta-cure (cyanoacrylate)
- 7mm Barrel Trimmer

## Preparing the Blanks:

- Cut a $5 / 8$ " blank to the size of the brass tube (add $1 / 16$ " for trimming the ends).
- Drill a 7 mm center hole through the blank.
- Spread glue over the tube, insert into the blank with a twisting motion, to spread the glue evenly inside, center the tube in the blank
- When glue dries, use a 7 mm barrel trimmer to square the ends of the blank. Take the wood down to the brass tube.

## Assembly

- Press the tip end into the narrow end of the barrel.
- Press the twist mechanism (brass end first) into the opposite end of the barrel. Continue to press pass the ID line until only $11 / 16$ " of chrome is exposed. Insert the refill and test for extension.
- Press the cap over the mechanism. The pen is now ready to use by turning the two ends to extract or retract the refill.

## Turning the Blank

- Place the bushing and blank on the mandrel according to the diagram "B". Use the smaller bushing for the tip end and the larger in the \#1432 set for the center.
- Turn the blank between the bushings into a desired profile.
- Flnish the barrel with your preferred choice of finish. -
